Wall Street falls 2 percent following remarks by Fed's Powell

NEW YORK (Reuters) - U.S. stocks extended losses and the S&P 500 hit a session low in Friday afternoon trading after Federal Reserve Chairman Jerome Powell said the U.S. central bank will likely need to keep raising interest rates to keep inflation under control.

In a speech in Chicago on the U.S. economic outlook, Powell said the labor market appeared close to full employment. It was his first speech on the economic outlook since taking over as chairman on Feb. 5.

Stocks already were sharply lower before the comments following U.S. President Donald Trump's latest tariff threat late Thursday on Chinese imports, which revived fears of a trade war between the two countries.

"The market wouldn't be acting nearly as negative to all the news in general if it would not be in a vulnerable state already," said Jim Paulsen, chief investment strategist at The Leuthold Group in Minneapolis.

"It's got higher values, financial liquidity is contracting, you came into the year with a little too much optimism, you got rising rates going on, you got rising inflation fears," he said.

Trump threatened to slap \$100 billion more in tariffs on Chinese imports, while Beijing said it was fully prepared to respond with a "fierce counter strike".

The Dow Jones Industrial Average .DJI fell 565.49 points, or 2.31 percent, to 23,939.73, the S&P 500 .SPX lost 53.08 points, or 1.99 percent, to 2,609.76 and the Nasdaq Composite .IXIC dropped 134.34 points, or 1.9 percent, to 6,942.21.

Fears of a trade war since Trump announced tariffs on steel and aluminum imports more than a month ago have kept investors on edge over concerns that such protectionist measures would hit global economic growth.

"It's a reaction to concerns about the administration's approach to trade. The market has vacillated between writing it off as just talk and assuming there could be a serious problem," said Rick Meckler, president of investment firm LibertyView Capital Management in Jersey City, New

Panic! Don't panic! Navigating the trade talk proves dicey

NEW YORK (Reuters) - "Don't overreact," President Donald Trump's chief economic adviser told investors on Wednesday, when U.S. stocks were deep in the red over worries about the administration's plan for \$50 billion of import duties aimed at China. Wall Street seemed to take heart from National Economic Council Director Larry Kudlow's calming words in a Fox Business Network interview during his first week on the job, and the market turned itself around. The Dow Jones Industrial Average rallied more than 700 points from the day's low. That trust looked misguided a day later, when Trump - seemingly unbeknownst to Kudlow - said he had instructed an additional \$100 billion of tariffs to be imposed on Chinese goods. Equities swooned again, with the Dow dropping roughly 600 points. It wouldn't be the first time that traders and investors got caught out by a seeming 180-degree turn on Trump policy, but Wall Street may have to get far more selective in terms of which statements, and from whom, they listen to.

"More typically, there's a lot more cohesion in the messaging between the White House and the markets," said Nicholas Colas, co-founder of DataTrek Research. "Certain-

ly this administration is taking an entirely different tack. It's been much more volatile in trying to understand what they're trying to tell us."

With rapid turn-about in the White House a regular occurrence, investors have made costly decisions based on the words of a rotating door of advisers and policy makers.

Peter Tuz, president of Chase Investment Counsel in Charlottesville, Virginia, said there was some "good cop, bad cop action" between the President and advisers.

"Obviously you listen to them both and you hope cooler heads eventually prevail," said Tuz. "It makes you sit on your hands a little bit more and not make any decision that might come back to bite you should these tariffs really sink in."

A similar to-and-fro has played out with the dollar. U.S. Treasury Secretary Steven Mnuchin said in January that he welcomed a weaker currency, Trump said he wanted to see a strong dollar, and then Kudlow in March said he would like the greenback a "wee bit stronger than it is currently." The dollar got whipsawed.

Texas police offer up to \$8,000 for arrest of wanted sex offender

The reward for a top 10 most wanted sex offender in Texas is up to \$8,000, if information provided to police this month ends in an arrest.

Monroe Hernandez, 51, is wanted for a parole violation warrant from the Texas Board of Pardons and Paroles that was issued on Sept. 10, 2014.

The Texas Department of Public Safety said the Waco Police Department issued another warrant for Hernandez on April 11, 2016, for failing to comply with sex offender registration requirements. Hernandez's last known location was in the 2400 block of La Salle Avenue in Waco. Police did not say what date Hernandez was last seen at that location.

According to DPS, Hernandez was convicted of sexual assault in McLennan County in an incident involving a 21-year-old woman in 1993. He was sentenced to six years in prison.

In 2001, Hernandez was convicted of driving while intoxicated in McLennan County and received a 17-year sentence since he had at least two prior DWI convictions. He was paroled in March 2014.

The sex offender is 5-foot-5 and weighs approximately 180 pounds. Police said he has tattoos on his chest, left hand and both legs, but authorities did


not describe what the tattoos look like. He also has scars on his left leg and right arm.

To get the \$8,000 reward, the information leading to Hernandez's arrest has to be reported in April. Police did not disclose the amount of the original reward.



Report: 'Great Pacific Garbage Patch' Has Grown to Twice the Size of Texas

The immense mass of predominantly plastic waste floats halfway between California and Hawaii, as a large part of the more than five trillion pieces of plastic garbage currently polluting our planet's most precious resource.

The Ocean Cleanup Foundation's spokesman, Dubois, called it "a ticking time bomb of larger material." He emphasized that "we've got to get it before it breaks down into a size that's too small to collect and also dangerous for marine life."

'Ghost nets' like these make up

Plastic is everywhere, from our homes and everyday lives all the way up to the illusorily pristine Arctic. The oceans are no exception—our high seas are accumulating plastic just as fast as we can push it out into the world.

In a new paper in Scientific Reports, researchers found that the infamous great Pacific garbage patch contains 16 times more plastic than previous estimates showed, and it seems to be increasing over time.



"We did some research a few years back trying to assess how much plastic is floating on the ocean, and we found that using those methods we're giving a bias to small debris," says Laurent Lebreton, lead study author and oceanographer at The Ocean Cleanup.

The Ocean Cleanup is a foundation focused on removing debris from the oceans. They plan to deploy technology to scoop up manufactured debris, a plan that drew criticism when announced.




These larger pieces of plastic, like bottles, lids, and fishing nets, are all far denser than tiny particles of plastic. As a result, they add a lot to the total debris estimates.

By weight, the larger plastics (two inches or more) make up most of that total. Microplastics were vastly more numerous—but being tiny, didn't contribute nearly as much to the weight.

Plastic nets can continue to catch fish and other marine life long after they are abandoned to the sea. This is called ghost fishing, and becomes a larger problem with every net or trap that is tossed overboard.

"The prevalence of ghost nets and discarded fishing gear is well documented, so this is not necessarily surprising," White said. "But the authors have done an excellent job of using a variety of survey methods to quantify this debris."

The authors also found that the sheer mass of plastic in the oceans has gone up over time, from 0.88 pounds per 0.39 square miles in the 1970s to 2.7 pounds per 0.39 square miles in 2015.

"One thing that has been increasing over time, really, is plastic consumption on a global scale," Lebreton says. "We are using more and more plastic in our societies."

Though the study found a lot more debris than previous estimates, it still doesn't account for a lot of the plastic that makes its way out to the ocean only to disappear.

"The challenge with microplastics in particular is that it really is not feasible to clean them up," White said. "Reducing the waste stream is the only current means to slow the inputs of plastic to our ocean."
