Trump lashes out after Russia probe, cites 'treasonous' and 'evil' acts

WASHINGTON (Reuters) - President Donald Trump lashed out at unnamed enemies on Monday, accusing them of evil actions and treason, a day after his attorney general released a summary of Special Counsel Robert Mueller's findings clearing the president's campaign of conspiring with Russia in the 2016 U.S. election.

"We're glad it's over. It's 100 percent the way it should have been," Trump told reporters at the White House. "I wish it could have gone a lot sooner, a lot quicker."

"There are a lot of people out there that have done some very, very evil things, very bad things, I would say treasonous things against our country," Trump added without mentioning anyone by name or citing specific actions. Attorney General William Barr, the top U.S. law enforcement official, on Sunday released a four-page summary of the findings of Mueller's 22-month investigation that detailed Russian interference in the 2016 U.S. election, but said the special counsel had concluded that Trump's campaign did not conspire with Moscow.

A fierce fight was brewing on Monday over how much of Mueller's Russia investigation findings should be made public. Democrats are demanding a full release but a lawyer for the president said key information - such as Trump's written responses in the inquiry - must be withheld.

Trump indicated that he wants new investigations, although he did not specify who would conduct them or who should be targeted. Trump in the past has called for investigations of Hillary Clinton, the Democratic candidate he defeated in 2016.

"Those people will certainly be looked at. I've been looking at them for a long time," he said in the Oval Office while sitting alongside visiting Israeli Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu. "And I'm saying, why haven't they been looked at? They lied to Congress. Many of them. And you know who they are."

"We can never let this happen to another president again."

Apple enters video streaming, updates news, game and payment apps

CUPERTINO, Calif. (Reuters) - Apple Inc attempted to reintroduce itself on Monday as an entertainment and financial services company that also makes iPhones as it launched a streaming television service, a credit card and an online gaming arcade. The world's second-most most valuable technology company lifted the curtain on a television and movie streaming service called Apple TV+ that will stream television shows and movies - both Apple originals and those from other creators - to users of its 1.4 billion gadgets worldwide, smart TVs and other devices.

The move could be seen as a first step to challenging streaming video leaders Netflix and Amazon.

Apple also introduced a credit card, a video game arcade, and added hundreds of magazines to its news app at Apple's Cupertino, California, headquarters.

As Apple struggles with saturated markets and sales of its iPhone fall, the company is turning more of its attention to services that provide regular subscription revenue.


Hollywood celebrities helped debut the revamped television offering. Apple has commissioned programming from Jennifer Aniston, Reese Witherspoon, Oprah Winfrey and Steven Spielberg.

Throughout the presentation, Apple executives stressed privacy protections for consumers as they shop and consume content across a range of Apple phones, iPads or other hardware.

They also emphasized content that would appeal to young audiences, potentially setting the stage for a rivalry with Walt Disney Co.

Winfrey announced a global book club.

The company, second only to Microsoft Corp in market value among tech giants, led off the event with an announcement that its free news

Apple Is Targeting April To Launch Its New Video Service -- But Without Netflix And Probably Without HBO

OVERVIEW

Apple is targeting April to debut a new streaming product that will include original content free for Apple device owners and a platform to subscribe to other digital media services.

HBO hasn't signed on to the service yet but still may do so. But Netflix and Hulu aren't expected to be a part of the "Channels" service.

Apple is in the final stages of preparing its new streaming video service, which will feature free original content for device owners and a subscription platform for existing digital services. But don't expect Netflix to be a part of it, and HBO's participation is also in doubt, according to people familiar with the matter.

Apple is aiming to launch service in April or early May. It will allow customers to sign up for existing digital streaming products and watch them in the iOS TV application, similar to Amazon's Prime Video Channels. Apple wants to simplify mobile video viewing by housing content in one app instead of forcing users to launch separate apps for each service. Lions Gate's Starz; CBS, which owns Showtime; and Viacom are expected to offer subscription streaming services on the Apple platform, according to people familiar with the matter, who asked not to be named because the discussions are

private. HBO may join its premium network brethren but isn't as far along in discussions with Apple, one of the people said. Apple hasn't offered HBO the same terms that Amazon offered, said the person.

While the exact disagreement between Apple and HBO isn't known, media companies have been concerned about data sharing and revenue splits as Apple tries to aggregate existing services in new ways. For instance, The Wall Street Journal reported Tuesday that Apple is pushing to take nearly 50 percent of revenue

derived from a new subscription news service it's planning to launch later this year.

Apple is pushing for a 30 percent cut on every customer that subscribes to an over-the-top video service through its streaming service, three of the people said. Currently, Apple takes a 15 percent cut on revenue from customers that sign up to HBO Now, Netflix, and other streaming apps through the App Store, two people said.

Netflix and Hulu aren't part of Amazon Prime Video Channels and aren't expected to be a part of Apple's product either, according to people familiar with the matter.

Spokespeople at Apple, CBS, HBO, Hulu, Netflix, Starz and Viacom declined to comment.

Apple has jostled with traditional media companies for years over getting access to their content. CEO Tim Cook previewed Apple's new offering on the company's earnings conference call last month.

"We see huge changes in customer behavior taking place now and we think that it will accelerate as the year goes by with the breakdown of the cable bundle. I think that it'll likely take place at a much faster pace this year," Cook said. "We will participate in the original content world. We have signed a multi-year partnership with Oprah, but today I'm not really ready to extend that conversation be-

yond that point. We've hired some great people that we have a super amount of confidence in, and we'll have something to say more on that later."

Apple's deal with Oprah Winfrey and other big entertainment names like Reese Witherspoon and Steven Spielberg will give Apple device owners access to both film and TV content for no additional charge. Apple is planning to offer its original content free to device users, CNBC first reported in October. Apple planned to spend about \$1 billion on originals last year, the Wall Street Journal



Special Counsel Robert Mueller Ends Investigation

It's too soon to say what Mueller's report will ultimately mean for the President, but surviving the investigation without being subpoenaed for a sit down interview with the special counsel's team is a significant triumph for Trump and his legal team.

A looming fight over Mueller's report Barr wrote in his letter that Justice Department leaders never told the special counsel throughout the investigation a proposed action should not be pursued.

The fight to make Mueller's report public could be fierce and possibly spark a court battle between Congress and the executive branch. Key House Democrats have said that the full report that Mueller submitted to Barr should be made public, and they intend to subpoena for the document -- and Mueller's underlying evidence -- if it is not handed over to Congress.

Congressional Democrats and Democratic presidential candidates issued a flurry of statements Friday demanding that Barr make Mueller's full report public, along with Mueller's evidence.

"We look forward to getting the full Mueller report and related materials," said House Judiciary Chairman Jerry Nadler, a New York Democrat.

"I will work with ranking member (Dianne) Feinstein and our House Judiciary Committee colleagues to ensure as much transparency as possible, consistent with the law," said Senate Judiciary Chairman Lindsey

Graham.

Graham, a South Carolina Republican, also noted that Trump did not interfere in Mueller's investigation, something Democrats expressed concerns about throughout the course of the investigation.

What Mueller found Mueller did not speak publicly during his nearly two-year investigation into Trump and his team. Instead, his prosecutors largely used indictments and court filings to illustrate their sweeping investigation.

The investigation revealed that Russia's efforts to influence the 2016 election were far more extensive than previously known, and multiple Trump associates lied about their contacts with Russian officials and others with ties to Moscow.

The list of officials in Trump's orbit who have pleaded guilty in Mueller's probe is lengthy, including former Trump campaign chairman Paul Manafort, former Trump White House national security adviser Michael Flynn, former Trump personal attorney Michael Cohen, former Trump campaign deputy Rick Gates and former Trump campaign adviser George Papadopoulos.

Trump had repeatedly attacked Mueller's investigation as a "witch hunt" and a "hoax," sending hundreds of tweets that have gone

after Mueller and his team of prosecutors, as well as Cohen after he began cooperating with Mueller. Earlier this month, Trump launched into a long broadside against the probe in a two-hour speech at the Conservative Political Action Conference, summing up the criticisms he's launched throughout the Mueller probe.

"You put the wrong people in a couple of positions, and they leave people for a long time that shouldn't be there, and all of a sudden, they're trying to take you out with bullshit, OK," Trump said.

Other investigations continue As of Friday, Robert Mueller is "still special counsel," according to a Justice Department official. But the investigation is unequivocally "complete," the official said.

While Mueller's investigation is finished, the investigations into Trump, his business and his administration are far from over. The new Democratic-controlled House has announced investigations into all elements of Trump's life, while Mueller's team has farmed out some cases to other prosecutors across the Justice Department that will continue, such as the probe into the Trump inaugural committee's donations and spending.

Gates, a key Mueller witness, continues to cooperate in several ongoing investigations, prosecutors said this month.

On Capitol Hill, Cohen testified publicly last month, accusing Trump of directing him to issue hush-money payments to two women alleging affairs, which Trump has denied, and alleging Trump committed financial fraud. Multiple committees are now pursuing other Trump Organization associates for testimony, as well as Trump's family members like Donald Trump Jr.

But the biggest question for Congress may ultimately be tied to Mueller's investigation, and whether his findings spark an effort in the House to begin impeachment proceedings against the President.

House Speaker Nancy Pelosi said earlier this month that impeaching the President was "just not worth it." But Mueller's findings could amplify the liberal voices in the House Democratic caucus already calling for Trump's impeachment. (Courtesy cnn.com)

After a 22-month investigation, charges against 37 defendants, seven guilty pleas and one conviction at trial, the Justice Department announced Friday that the special counsel's office has wrapped up its probe into Russian election interference, possible Trump campaign collusion with Moscow and obstruction of justice.

A senior Justice Department official told CNN there are no more indictments coming from special counsel Robert Mueller.

Mueller submitted a confidential report to Attorney General William Barr Friday detailing the decisions his team made to prosecute or not prosecute those who were investigated, Barr said in a letter to lawmakers.

Barr wrote that he "may be in a position to advise you of the special counsel's principal conclusions as soon as this weekend. Lawmakers did receive the principal conclusions, in writing, from Barr over the weekend, according to a Justice Department official. That distillation from Barr will later be made public.

Press Secretary Sarah Sanders said that, "The next steps are up to Attorney General Barr, and we look forward to the process taking its course. The White House has not received or been briefed on the Special Counsel's report," Sanders said in a statement.

The completion of the special counsel's investigation marks the end of one of the most dramatic chapters in Donald Trump's presidency, one that led to numerous criminal charges against and guilty pleas by some of his closest associates. The conclusion of the investigation, however, opens a new chapter into the fallout from the report, a potentially fraught political battle over the extent to which its contents are made public and further investigations from congressional Democrats.
