# Facebook targets harmful real networks, using playbook against fakes

Sept 16 (Reuters) - Facebook (FB.O) is taking a more aggressive approach to shut down coordinated groups of real-user accounts engaging in certain harmful activities on its platform, using the same strategy its security teams take against campaigns using fake accounts, the company told Reuters

The new approach, reported here for the first time, uses the tactics usually taken by Facebook's security teams for wholesale shutdowns of networks engaged in influence operations that use false accounts to manipulate public debate, such as Russian troll farms.

It could have major implications for how the social media giant handles political and other coordinated movements breaking its rules, at a time when Facebook's approach to abuses on its platforms is under heavy scrutiny from global lawmakers and civil society groups.

Facebook said it now plans to take this same network-level approach with groups of coordinated real accounts that systemically break its rules, through mass reporting, where many users falsely report a target's content or account to get it shut down, or brigading, a type of online harassment where users might coordinate to target an individual through mass posts or comments.

In a related change, Facebook said on Thursday that would be taking the same type of approach to campaigns of real users that cause "coordinated social harm" on and off its platforms, as it announced a takedown of the German anti-COVID restrictions Ouerdenken movement.

These expansions, which a spokeswoman said were in their early stages, means Facebook's security teams could identify core movements driving such behavior and take more sweeping actions than the company removing posts or individual accounts as it otherwise might.

In April, BuzzFeed News published a leaked Facebook internal report about the company's role in the Jan. 6 riot on the U.S. Capitol and its challenges in curbing the fast-growing 'Stop the Steal' movement, where one of the findings was Facebook had "little policy around coordinated authentic harm."

Facebook's security experts, who are separate from the company's content moderators and handle threats from adversaries trying to evade its rules, started cracking down on influence operations using fake accounts in 2017, following the 2016 U.S. election in which U.S. intelligence officials concluded Russia had used social media platforms as part of a cyber-influence campaign - a claim Moscow has denied

Facebook dubbed this banned activity by the groups of fake accounts "coordinated inauthentic behavior" (CIB), and its security teams started announcing sweeping takedowns in monthly reports. The security teams also handle some specific threats that may not use fake accounts, such as fraud or cyber-espionage networks or overt influence operations like some state media campaigns.

Sources said teams at the company had long debated how it should intervene at a network level for large movements of real user accounts systemically breaking its rules.

In July, Reuters reported on the Vietnam army's online information warfare unit, who engaged in actions including mass reporting of accounts to Facebook buwwt also often used their real names. Facebook removed some accounts over these mass reporting attempts.

Facebook is under increasing pressure from global regulators, lawmakers and employees to combat wide-ranging abuses on its services. Others have criticized the company over allegations of censorship, anti-conservative bias or inconsistent enforcement.

wAn expansion of Facebook's network disruption models to affect authentic accounts raises further questions about how changes might impact types of public debate, online movements and campaign tactics across the political spectrum.

"A lot of the time problematic behavior will look very close to social movements," said Evelyn Douek, a Harvard Law lecturer who studies platform governance. "It's going to hinge on this definition of harm ... but obviously people's definitions of harm can be quite subjective and nebu-

High-profile instances of coordinated activity around last year's U.S. election, from teens and K-pop fans claiming they used TikTok to sabotage a rally for former President Donald Trump in Tulsa, Oklahoma, to political campaigns paying online meme-makers, have also sparked debates on how platforms should define and approach coordinated campaigns.



### **WHO Chief Urges Nations To Join** In Preventing 'Vaccine Nationalism'

Urging countries to join a global vaccine agreement. the head of the World Health Organization on Tuesday reiterated concerns that, once developed, drugs to prevent COVID-19 might be hoarded by some countries at the expense of others. Speaking in Geneva, WHO Director-General Tedros Adhanom Ghebreyesus issued a call to avoid "vaccine nationalism" by joining the COVAX Global Vaccines Facility - a pact aimed at ensuring access to such drugs around the world. WHO has set an Aug. 31 deadline to establish terms for the new pact. Tedros said he sent a letter to the WHO's 194 member states, urging participation.

"Nationalism exacerbated the pandemic and contributed to the total failure of the global supply chain," he said, noting that hoarding by some countries led to shortages of protective gear in the early days of the pandemic. He said that the world's interconnectedness means that "a vaccine developed in one country may need to be filled in vials with stoppers that are produced in another, using materials for the high-grade glass that is only available from yet another country. Sharing finite supplies strategically and globally is actually in each country's national interest," Tedros said. WHO's push for an international pact to share vaccines comes as the European Union, Britain, Switzerland and the United States are forging deals with drugmakers that have prospective COVID-19 vaccines in various stages of trials. China and Russia also are working on vaccines. According to a Johns Hopkins University tally, since the start of the pandemic, there have been nearly 22 million coronavirus cases worldwide, with nearly 776,000 deaths.

#### 'Vaccine nationalism' threatens global plan to distribute COVID-19 shots fairly

As soon as the first COVID-19 vaccines get approved. a staggering global need will confront limited supplies. Many health experts say it's clear who should get the first shots: health care workers around the world, then people at a higher risk of severe disease, then those in areas where the disease is spreading rapidly, and finally, the rest of us. Such a strategy "saves the most lives and slows transmission the fastest," says Christopher Elias, who heads the Bill & Melinda Gates Foundation's Global Development Division. "It would be ludicrous if low-risk people in rich countries get the vaccine when health care workers in South Africa don't," adds Ellen 't Hoen, a Dutch lawyer and public health activist. Yet money and national interest may win out. The United States and Europe are placing advance orders for hundreds of millions of doses of successful vaccines, potentially leaving little for poorer parts of the world. "I'm very concerned," says John Nkengasong, director of the Africa Centres for Disease Control and Prevention.

To avoid such a scenario, the World Health Organiza-

tion and other international organizations have set up a system to accelerate and equitably distribute vaccines, the COVID-19 Vaccines Global Access (COVAX) Facility, which seeks to entice rich countries to sign on by reducing their own risk that they're betting on the wrong vaccine candidates But the idea has been put together on the fly, and it's unclear how many rich countries will join



Recent history isn't encouraging. A cocktail of powerful antiviral drugs revolutionized HIV treatment in the West in 1996, saving many lives, but it took 7 years for the drugs to become widely available in Africa, the hardest hit continent, "That was catastrophic and that experience is high in my mind." Nkengasong says. During the 2009 H1N1 influenza pandemic, the United States and many European countries donated 10% of their vaccine stocks to poorer countries—but only after it became clear they had enough for their own populations. "Too many had to wait too long for too little," says Richard Hatchett, CEO of the Coalition for Epidemic Preparedness Innovations, a partner

This time, too, rich countries' biggest concern is to protect their own citizens. The U.S. government has signed deals worth more than \$6 billion with several vaccine companies as part of Operation Warp Speed, which aims to provide the U.S. population with vaccines by January 2021. Europe's Inclusive Vaccines Alliance, formed by France, Germany. Italy, and the Netherlands, has signed a deal to buy 400 million doses of AstraZeneca's vaccine for use in EU member states. The United Kingdom has inked deals with AstraZeneca and other companies as well. China is developing its own vaccines; it's unclear how early it will be willing to share or whether the shots will come with political strings attached. The idea behind COVAX is to invest in about 12 different vaccines and ensure early access when they become available. "The goal is to have 2 billion doses by the end of 2021," says Seth Berkley, director of GAVI, the Vaccine Alliance, the third COVAX partner: 950 million for highand upper middle-income countries, 950 million for low- and lower middle-income countries, and

# Vaccinations are on the rise as cities —

on the heels of major companies and other organizations — implement stricter vaccination rules.

New Orleans announced Thursday that effective Aug. 16 it would require proof of vaccination or a negative Covid test for indoor dining, bars, gyms, indoor entertainment and large outdoor events. "This is in addition to the indoor mask

mandate and in an effort to curb the unprecedented level of hospitalizations statewide and the growing number of deaths due to the more contagious and more deadly Delta variant," the city said in a statement.

And San Francisco Mayor London Breed also announced Thursday that the city will be requiring proof of vaccination for patrons and employees of restaurants, bars, theaters, gyms and large events. Breed said the requirement for full proof of vaccination for patrons in indoor public settings would begin Aug. 20 and the proof of vaccination requirement for staff members would begin Oct. 13 to allow time for full vac-



We know that for our city to bounce back from the pandemic and thrive, we need to use the best method we have to fight Covid-19 and that's vaccines,' Breed said in a statement. "Many San Francisco businesses are already leading the way by requiring proof of vaccination for their customers because they care about the health of their employees, their customers, and this City. This order builds on their leadership and will help us weather the challenges ahead and keep our businesses open. Vaccines are our way out of the pandemic, and our way back to a life where we can be together safely."

The two announcements, some of the first in the country, followed the lead of New York City after it announced this month that it would require proof of vaccination for leisure indoor activities at restaurants, gyms and performances, becoming the first major city in the United States to do so.

Mayor Bill de Blasio said the program

will begin in mid-August during a transition period before it will be fully enforced beginning the week of Sept. 13.

'It is time for people to see vaccinations as literally necessary to living a good, full and healthy life," he said at the time. "If you're unvaccinated, unfortunately, you will not be able to participate in many things."

As cities have begun announcing vaccine mandates, more than a dozen large corporate employers have recently done the same. President Joe Biden has also been expanding the list of federal workers mandated to get the vaccine, with the latest announcement Thursday adding all Health and Human Services employees who may come in contact with pa-

#### New 'MU' COVID Variant Now Found In 49 U.S. States

Since being discovered in Colombia in January, the mu variant of COVID-19 has spread to nearly four dozen countries and has made its presence known in Hawaii and Alaska. It has so far been found in 49 states with Nebraska being the only state to not have a mu variant case detected.

Health officials believe mu is even more transmissible than the delta variant and has the potential to resist vaccines.

In the U.S., the mu variant has been de-

tected in 49 states and the District of Columbia, according to Newsweek.

California has reported the highest number of the latest variant with 384. A total of 167 of those cases were found in Los Angeles County.

"The identification of variants like mu, and the spreading of variants across the globe, highlights the need for L.A. County residents to continue to take measures to protect themselves and others," said Dr. Barbara Ferrer, director of LA County Public Health, in a statement.

"This is what makes getting vaccinated and layering protections so important. These are actions that break the chain of transmission and limits COVID-19 proliferation that allows for the virus to mutate into something that could be more dangerous.'

On Aug. 30, the World Health Organization called the mu variant a variant of interest due to its ability to be more transmissible than any of the other strains of COVID-19.

The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention has not yet made similar classifications about mu in the U.S.

Dr. Anthony Fauci, director of the National Institute of Allergy and Infectious Diseases, said that health officials were maintaining a "close eye" on the mu variant despite it being "not at all even close" to becoming the dominant COVID-19 strain in the U.S.

"Even though it has not in essence taken hold to any extent here we always pay attention to at all times variants," Fauci said. The U.S. saw its peak of mu variant

cases in mid-July but case numbers involving that variant have been declining since, signaling either a weakening of the strain or indicating a worrisome future. (Courtesy https://www.nydaily-

# 文老师怎么从未教过:

的美食,那些看似"苦大仇深"现实主义作。 么,大概,民国时的莲花白是清新可人的吧 品里,却饱含对生活深沉的热爱——《狂人 日记》中的蒸鱼、《祝福》里的清炖鱼翅、 《孔乙己》里的盐煮笋……

鲁迅不愧为中国现代文学的奠基人之一 ,这些充满人间烟火的细节,更见一个文学 大家成熟而深厚的功力。

小时候老师上课,按着教学大纲贴标签 。说起鲁迅先生的小说,总不免强调"批判 、抨击"之类,又要提炼中心思想,又要归 纳段落大意……

可是说到《红楼梦》,虽然也是"批判 了封建社会的ABCDEFG",可是衣裳饮食 ,却能——读来。

其实书本无辜,读者有心。鲁迅先生的 小说也是小说,也有描绘世情之处。单把他 的小说是炼中心思想,太可惜了。

先生既对现实主义小说有好感,描摹极 精。《呐喊》里多写浙江乡间风物,就写得 很细

《狂人日记》最吓人的一句是说蒸鱼, "鱼的眼睛,白而且硬,张着嘴,同那一伙 想吃人的人一样。吃了几筷,滑溜溜的不知 是鱼是人"。我初看这句后,几个月见蒸鱼 都毛骨悚然。后来重读,想到另一个点:

"原来浙江人也蒸鱼啊!"

有广东朋友对我总结,有资格被蒸的鱼 是好鱼。被蒸的鱼自己未必快乐,但可见品 第之尊。在江苏、浙江、广东几地吃的蒸鱼 ,有些差别。江浙蒸鱼,除了浙江临海的之 外,多为河鲜湖鲜,有江鲜最好。粤地蒸鱼 ,有相当的比例是海鱼。江浙不靠海的长辈 们,吃鱼更多吃个细,吃个味道。我们老家 那里,普遍不把鱼当肉菜,就吃个鲜。粤地 蒸鱼里,有相当部分是所谓实肉鱼。白仓、 桂花、龙趸。是能吃到肉头的。

我认得许多老广东人家,会自制豉油来 蒸色,无论先腌后蒸还是清蒸完佐酱油,都 是精细活,火候是差不得丝毫的,非高手莫 办。

《端午节》里的方玄绰,是个"差不多 先生",气质更接近《彷徨》里的知识分子 。虽然百无一用是书生,但是颇油滑有无赖 气,没钱了还让仆人去赊莲花白来喝。

莲花白这种酒,创制的年代说法颇多, 元明清的说头都有。我听过的一种做法至简 易,白酒加莲花蕊泡即可。传说民国时,北 京的莲花白是宝竹坡先生发明的,又都说秋 巧些,似乎配蒸鱼的居多。

我们好像都不约而同忽略了鲁迅文本中 天喝莲花白吃熏雁翅听秋雨是人生妙境,那

《故乡》里有著名的闰十和瓜田,以及 豆腐两施汶个名角色。闰十给汛哥川送了自 家晒的青豆。我们乡下也晒青豆,一般放在 大匾里晒于土场。晒干后配笋丝,可以当零 食吃,可以下粥。青豆不如干黄豆脆,嚼来 很韧,是方便又耐吃的小食。闰土送的礼很 合于早年乡间规范:不贵重,但耐吃耐藏, 确实有用。新鲜的青豆,我自己习惯拿来炒

迅哥儿的母亲知道闰土没吃午饭,便让 他自己到厨下炒饭吃去。我很怀疑此处的炒 饭就是油炒干饭。我小时候吃惯的是蛋炒饭 一虽然我妈技艺寻常,只是普通的碎金饭, 做不来"金包银",但终究有蛋。有年下乡 被留午饭,乡邻端来一碗油炒饭,一碗酱油 葱丝汤。乡间简朴,油炒饭就是油和盐将饭 一炒,取一点油香和味道,不至于让你嚼干 饭之意。江南乡下似乎多有类似作风:炒饭 好过白饭,劣茶好过白水,总归得意思一下 ,不然唐突了客人。

《孔乙己》里有黄酒、盐煮笋和著名的

黄酒在浙江籍作家的书里必不可少,余 华《许三观卖血记》里黄酒就是重要剧情道 具。盐煮笋大概是盐水煮笋,是下酒的好东 西。也有人跟我说盐煮笋就是扁尖,不太确 定。在我故乡,扁尖用来煮汤、炒肉等,远 多于下酒了。茴香豆随孔乙己名动天下,大 概桂皮、盐、茴香炮制蚕豆所制。酥软糯韧 ,其味隽永,名垂千古的零食,和金圣叹 "花生与豆腐干"一起,合为读书人的下酒

阿Q是中国小说史上一位奇人。既然如 此典型,少不得生活处处都典型,可以拿来 做20世纪初浙江无聊赖乡民的典范。

阿O喝黄酒,喝完了吹自己和赵太爷是 一家,挨了嘴巴。本来黄酒不如白酒之烈, 我所见喝黄酒者极少醉,大多脸红目亮,逸 兴遄飞。所以阿Q不常醉,只是兴致容易高

油煎大头鱼,未庄加半寸长葱叶,城里 加切细的葱丝。阿Q以未庄为标准,以城里 为错。这么一想,我家乡家常做菜,以葱调 味,都是放葱叶的。油煎红配葱叶碎绿,煞 是缤纷。葱丝切细似乎是馆子里的做法,细

阿O不小心对吴妈表白失败,在未庄成 朋友感叹说,许多 了过街老鼠,饿极思变,去尼姑庵偷东西吃 底层编辑就在重复 。没偷笋,因为未熟;油菜结子,荠菜将开 花,小白菜也老了一统统吃不得了。最后偷 了三个老萝卜,结果还几乎遭了狗咬。

这里的细节很到位:萝卜比起笋、油菜 、荠菜、白菜的好处,是可以生吃。老北京 时想吃的,就要来 有叫卖,"萝卜赛梨,辣了换",清凉爽脆 。赵丽蓉奶奶当年春节晚会上有个小品,有 是他也不知道龙虎 个菜叫"群英荟萃",说穿了就是萝卜开会 。巩汉林当时还编歌唱:"吃在嘴里特别的

当然阿Q还是很可怜的,因为拣的是个疑惑,蛇有啥好吃 "老萝卜"。我们这里吃萝卜,讲究新脆。 "吃了萝卜加热茶,气得大夫满街吧"的谚 语众所周知,但如果是凉茶+蔫萝卜,未免无 果,古代岭南庄田 趣。萝卜一软,口感打折。老萝卜无汁不脆 而且通常辣味重,不会太好吃。如果干脆做 成萝卜干倒还罢了,可惜阿Q连笋都懒得煮 蛇来吃,也算补充 ,多半是生吃的了。

鲁迅先生写《呐喊》,多绍兴农家乡野 气息。写《彷徨》,多城市里知识分子气。 但是开篇的《祝福》,倒还有些田园风。

旧时祝福主要是祭祀、杀鸡、宰鹅、买 猪肉。其实祖先已逝,一来未必吃得到,二 来未必爱吃一天上神仙爱吃金丹蟠桃,姑射 山仙人爱餐风饮露,你弄一堆高脂肪高蛋白 ,祖先未必消化吧。当然我国祭祀,主要是 给活人看的,所以以活人之心度死人之腹, 就这么吃了吧。

我问过浙江的朋友,他说,老年代祝福 ,是煮了五牲拜过,然后用煮五牲的水煮年 糕吃,以"散福"。我猜五牲白煮,好吃不



酱。鲁迅先生之爱吃辣,可见一斑。而且他 老人家口味颇重,感叹辣酱淡薄, "本来S 城的人是不懂吃辣的"

青鱼干,我故乡过年时家里会自制,取 "年年有余"的口彩。青鱼剖了,扎几个孔 ,用盐腌了,鱼头尾另剁了炖汤。我听说有 手艺好的人家,可以把青鱼用酒酿(四川所 谓醪糟)、酱油等腌糟再吃。小说里这里大 概是普通青鱼干,可以空口吃来下酒,也可 以蒸透了吃。

这一席菜上来后,小说所谓"楼上又 添了烟气和油豆腐的热气,仿佛热闹起来 了;楼外的雪也越加纷纷的下"。那意思 是,除了煮油豆腐加辣酱,其他菜大概都 属冷菜。本来小说格调清冷,的确也只适 合配这些菜。如果上一大碗冰糖肘子、红 烧鲫鱼、糖醋排骨,则小说的落寞调子, 就会被破坏了。这样黄酒、煮豆腐和几样 绍兴腌制冷下酒菜,倒和林冲风雪山神庙 的冷牛肉相似。你依然能感到寒意,但不 至于觉得人间冷绝。

本来冬天饮食,便是如此。吃麻辣火锅 到大汗淋漓,浑忘了今夕何夕的时候,毕竟太 少太少。大多数时候,我们也就和《在酒楼上 》一样,独自一人一点点地啜烫茶热酒。能如 小说中这样,在江南这清寒浸肤而不入骨的冬 季,凑出一点暖意,也就差不多了。


