First Republic Bank to receive billions of dollars from large banks - sources

March 16 (Reuters) - Several large banks are in talks to deposit billions of dollars at First Republic Bank (FRC.N) to salvage the embattled lender, according to people familiar with the matter.

The banks are set to deposit \$29 billion, one of the sources said.

This follows a round of financing on Sunday raised through JPMorgan Chase & Co (JPM.N), which gave First Republic access to a total of \$70 billion in funds, but failed to calm investors as worries of a contagion deepened in the wake of two large-scale collapses in the banking industry.

Besides JPMorgan Chase & Co (JPM.N), Citigroup Inc (C.N), Bank of America Corp (BAC.N) and Wells Fargo & Co (WFC.N) are part of the rescue, two of the sources said.

PNC Financial Services (PNC.N), Goldman Sachs Group Inc (GS.N), Morgan Stanley (MS.N), Truist Financial (TFC.N) and US Bancorp (USB.N) are also involved, both the sources added.

The effort was initiated by banks but had strong backing and encouragement from the government, according to a person with knowledge of the matter.

Eleven banks were involved and the rescue plan is supported by U.S. regulators, the person said.

Founded in 1985, First Republic had \$212 billion in assets and \$176.4 billion in deposits as of the end of last year, according to its annual report.

About 70% of its deposits are uninsured, above the median of 55% for medium-sized banks and the third highest in the group after Silicon Valley Bank and Signature Bank, according to a Bank of America note.

Earlier on Thursday, Reuters reported PacWest Corp (PACW.O) is also in talks about a liquidity boost with investment firm Atlas



SP Partners.

Banks including JPMorgan and Morgan Stanley are in talks with First Republic for a potential deal that could bolster its finances, several media reports said on Thursday.

The banks are set to deposit \$30 billion with First Republic in a concerted effort by the U.S. government to rescue the struggling lender, Bloomberg News reported on Thursday, citing people with knowledge of the matter.

U.S. lawmaker wants TikTok CEO to detail actions to protect kids

WASHINGTON, March 16 (Reuters) - The chair of a U.S. House of Representatives panel wants TikTok CEO Shou Zi Chew to address questions next week about the popular Chinese-owned video app's efforts to protect children from inappropriate content and potential exploitation.

Chew will be appearing for the first time before Congress when he testifies before the House Energy and Commerce Committee on March 23.

Committee Chair Cathy McMorris Rodgers, a Republican, said Thursday lawmakers "need to know what actions the company is taking to keep our kids safe from online and offline harms."

McMorris Rodgers and other Republicans in December wrote TikTok saying said "many children are exposed to nonstop offerings of inappropriate content that TikTok's algorithm force-feeds to them." They also raised concerns that TikTok livestreamed events allow adult TikTok users to offer monetary rewards to "persuade children to perform sexually suggestive

TikTok, owned by Chinese tech company ByteDance, said the Biden administration had threatened to ban the app in the United States if its Chinese owners did not sell their stakes in the company.

"Americans deserve to know the extent to which their privacy is jeopardized and their data is manipulated by ByteDwith China," she added. The U.S. government has raised concerns

that TikTok's user data could be passed on to China's government.

TikTok, which did not immediately comment, said earlier this month it is developing a tool that will allow parents to prevent their teens from viewing content containing certain words or hashtags on the short-form video app.

TikTok announced new features to help users limit the amount of time spent on the app. Accounts belonging to users under 18 will automatically have a time limit of one hour per day, and teens will need to enter a passcode to continue using the app. TikTok and the Biden administration have been negotiating for more than two years on data security requirements. TikTok said ance-owned TikTok's relationship it has spent more than \$1.5 billion on rigorous data security efforts and rejects spying allegations.

Tech giant Facebook laid off 13% of their employees in the Bay Area in late 2022, and earlier this year, Silicon Valley Bank discovered that their depositors were dropping out as their clientele of tech companies, who were heavily invested in venture capital funds, saw that their interest rates were going up.

President Biden Will End COVID Emergencies On May 11th

The move to end the COVID national emergency and public health emergency declarations would formally restructure the federal coronavirus response to treat the virus as an endemic threat to public health that can be managed hrough the various agencies' normal authorities.

WASHINGTON — President Joe Biden informed Congress on Monday that he will end the twin national emergencies for addressing COVID-19 on May 11, as most of the world has returned closer to normalcy nearly three years after they were first declared.

The move to end the national emergency and public health emergency declarations would formally restructure the federal coronavirus response to treat the virus as an endemic threat to public health that can be managed through agencies' normal authorities.

It comes as lawmakers have already ended elements of the emergencies that kept millions of Americans insured during the pandemic. Combined with the drawdown of most federal COVID-19 relief money, it would also shift the development of vaccines and treatments away from the direct management of the federal government.

Biden's announcement comes in a statement opposing resolutions being brought to the floor this week by House Republicans to bring the emergency to an immediate end. House Republicans are also gearing up to launch investigations on the federal government's response to COVID-19

Former President Donald Trump first declared the COVID-19 pandemic a national emergency on March 13, 2020. The emergencies have been repeatedly extended by Biden since he took office in January 2021, and are set to expire in the coming months. The White House said Biden plans to extend them both briefly to end on May 11. "An abrupt end to the emergency declarations would create wide-ranging chaos and uncertainty throughout the health care system — for states, for hospitals and doctors' offices, and, most importantly, for tens of millions of Americans," the Office of Management and Budget wrote in a Statement of Administration Policy.



President Biden Received His Covid Vaccine During the Emergencies.

Congress has already blunted the reach of the public health emergency that had the most direct impact on Americans, as political calls to end the declaration intensified. Lawmakers have refused for months to fulfill the Biden administration's request for billions more dollars to extend free COVID vaccines and testing. And the \$1.7 trillion spending package passed last year and signed into law by Biden put an end to a rule that barred states from kicking people off Medicaid, a move that is expected to see millions of people lose their coverage after April 1. The costs of COVID-19 vaccines are also expected to skyrocket once the government stops buying them, with

Pfizer saying it will charge as much as \$130 per dose.

Only 15% of Americans have received the recommend-

ed, updated booster that has been offered since last fall.




Once the emergency expires, people with private insur-

ance will have some out-of-pocket costs for vaccines, tests and treatment, while the uninsured will have to pay for those expenses in their entirety.

Legislators did extend telehealth flexibilities that were introduced as COVID-19 hit, leading health care systems around the country to regularly deliver care by smartphone or computer.

The Biden administration had previously considered ending the emergency last year, but held off amid concerns about a potential "winter surge" in cases and to provide adequate time for providers, insurers and patients to prepare for its end.



A senior administration official said the three months until the expiration would mark a transition period where the administration will "begin the process of a smooth operational wind-down of the flexibilities enabled

by the COVID-19 emergency declarations." The official spoke on the condition of anonymity to discuss the announcement before it had been released. More than 1.1 million people in the U.S. have died from

More than 1.1 million people in the U.S. have died from COVID-19 since 2020, according to the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, including about 3,700 last week.

Case counts have trended downward after a slight bump over the winter holidays, and are significantly below levels seen over the last two winters —though the number of tests performed for the virus and reported to public health officials has sharply decreased.

Moments before the White House's announcement, Rep. Tom Cole, R-Okla., accused the president of unnecessarily extending the public health emergency to take action on issues like foreiving some federal student loan debts.

"The country has largely returned to normal," Cole said Monday, introducing a Republican-backed bill calling for an end to the health emergency. "Everyday Americans have returned to work and to school with no restrictions on their activities. It is time that the government acknowledges this reality: the pandemic is over."

FDA Experts Urge Single Annual COVID Vaccine Formula For All, But Variants Are Still With Us. Recommendations Would Override The Original COVID Vaccine Mix.

The original COVID-19 vaccine formula introduced in December 2020 should be retired and replaced entirely with the updated mix tailored to recent virus variants, an FDA expert panel urged in a unanimous vote this week. The Food and Drug Administration's Vaccines and Related Biological Products Advisory Committee was asked to consider whether to recommend a single vaccine composition for all situations, the so-called bivalent formula based both on the original virus strain and the more recent



"This isn't only a convenience thing to increase the number of people vaccinated, which is extremely important," said Dr. Hayley Gans, pediatrics professor at Stanford University Medical Center, during Thursday's panel discussion. "But also I think moving toward the strains that are circulating is important."

But COVID'S ever-evolving mutations make that difficult. Even the strains the updated booster shot was designed to protect against are rapidly vanishing. The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention indicates that the omicron BA.4 variant is no longer circulating and that BA.5 only represents about 2% of cases nationally, edged out by XBB.1.15, which now accounts for about half of infections.

"I do think it's important to get closer to the circulating strains," said Dr. Paul Offit, a pediatrics professor at Children's Hospital of Philadelphia.



It was unclear how soon the FDA might put the committee's recommendation into action.

The move comes as a succession of omicron variants of the virus that causes COVID-19 continues to infect the vaccinated, boosted and unvaccinated, but hospitalizations and deaths haven't soared as they did in past winter waves of infection since the virus emerged three years ago, in early 2020.

Last year, the FDA experts urged new booster shots based on both the original virus strain that emerged in Wuhan, China and some of the newer omicron virus variants, known as BA.4 and BA.5.

known as BA.4 and BA.5.

But that updated formula was only recommended for boosters to goose the immune response for the already vaccinated. Those who had not been vaccinated had to get the original vaccine based on a now-extinct strain. Health

officials said the original vaccine still showed strong pro-



Experts have said low vaccination rates since then suggest the strategy wasn't popular. Currently, 61% of Americans and 75% of Californians have had the primary, two-dose COVID-19 vaccination. But only 15% nationally and 18% in California have had the single, updated booster

shot unveiled last fall. Others on the panel questioned the need for vaccines to

combat infections that don't produce symptoms.

"You can certainly make the argument an asymptomatic infection is desirable," said Dr. Cody Meissner, a pediatrics professor at Dartmouth-Hitchcock Medical Center in Lebanon, New Hampshire, adding it will "act as its own

During the open comment period, several people told the panel they had suffered severe side effects from the vaccines and felt the agency was downplaying the risks. Angie Bluford, who said she's a 49-year-old mother from Wilmington North Cambing said she got the Moderna

Wilmington, North Carolina, said she got the Moderna vaccine in April 2021 "to protect my family," thinking she was "doing the right thing," and that she felt ill the next day, with headaches, shortness of breath and other symptoms.

"My body is a shell of what it once was," she said. "Please hear us and help us."



Dr. Tom Shimabukuro of the CDC's immunization safety office said that the CDC is still investigating indications of a possible elevated stroke risk in older people that appeared in one of several safety monitoring networks and not others.

"The public and the medical community should be confident that the government has systems in place to rapidly detect safety problems," Shimabukuro said. "We are aware of these reports of people experiencing long-lasting health problems following COVID vaccination. No specific medical causes for the symptoms have been found. We will continue to monitor the safety of these vaccines." The panel concluded with discussions about future vaccine and booster schedules and dosages but made no recommendations. The \$16 TRILLION Bug — Pandemic May Cost U.S. Economy Total Annual Output

The U.S. economy may lose a whopping \$16 trillion due to the devastating impact of the Covid-19 outbreak, both in output and people's lives, new research has found. While most studies assess the costs of the deadly virus by its impact on the national gross domestic product (GDP), a paper published in the Journal of the American Medical Association earlier this week offered a different approach. The authors of the study – former Treasury Secretary Lawrence Summers and Harvard University economist David Cutler – also took into account losses associated with those who have died due to the virus, in addition to the purely economic costs. With the number of coronavirus infections in the US nearing eight million and deaths surpassing 215,000, the researchers believe that the outbreak may result in an estimated 625,000 cumulative deaths in the country through next year. Given the theoretical "conservative value of \$7 million per life," premature deaths linked to the coronavirus could wipe out nearly \$4.4 trillion, according to their calculations.

The virus is believed to have long-term effects on health, especially for survivors with severe or critical disease. As those complications lead to increased risk of premature death, they also have far-reaching consequences for the entire economy, with losses amounting to another \$2.6 trillion for cases forecast through the next year, the authors noted.



Even those who did not contact the deadly virus could also be affected by it, the paper adds. Suffering caused by the possible death of loved ones, as well as the effects of isolation and loneliness, may lead to deteriorating mental health conditions. This also takes its toll on the economy, which could lose approximately \$1.6 trillion due to mental health impairment, according to the research. The rest of the losses – nearly half of the total – are associated with a drop in income due to the coronavirus-triggered recession. The authors cited a previous estimate from the Congressional Budget Office, which projects a total of \$7.6 trillion in

lost output during the next decade.

"The economic loss is more than twice the total monetary outlay for all the wars the US has fought since September 11, 2001, including those in Afghanistan, Iraq, and Syria," the study reads. "The total cost is estimated at more than \$16 trillion, or approximately 90% of the annual gross domestic product of the US," it concludes, adding that the estimated loss for a family of four would reach nearly \$200,000.

The paper comes as US lawmakers debate another stimulus package, set to mitigate damage from the virus. The research stressed that any such economic relief should allocate at least five percent of the funds for increased testing and contact tracing, as an investment of approximately \$6 million leads to averted costs of an estimated \$176 million.



"Increased investment in testing and contact tracing could have economic benefits that are at least 30 times greater than the estimated costs of the investment in these approaches," the study said. It added that financial support for health measures should not be dismantled even when the concerns about the pandemic begin to recede.

U.S. Employers Cut Record 2 MIL-LION JOBS As Coronavirus Batters Economy

Job cuts announced by US employers have hit nearly 2 million so far this year, with the entertainment industry accounting for 40 percent of total layoffs, according to global outplacement firm Challenger, Gray & Christmas. In its report published on Thurs-

day, the company said that last month's layoffs in the US were down 56 percent from
July, but still 116 percent higher than at the
same period one year ago. August job cuts of
nearly 116,000 lifted the total number of this
year's layoffs to 1,963,458. The number has
already broken the previous record for the
whole of 2001, when US-based employers
announced a total of 1,956,876 cuts.

Most of the jobs – nearly 800,000 – vanished from the entertainment sector so far this year, followed by firms operating in retail and services. In August, entertainment and leisure companies, including bars, restaurants, hotels, and amusement parks, posted the second-highest number with 17,271 job cuts.

Air and transport companies downsized their staff even more last month. According to the report, 26,545 job cuts were announced in the struggling sector – 59 percent lower than in the previous month, but 647 percent higher than in August 2019.

"The leading sector for job cuts last month was transportation, as airlines begin to make staffing decisions in the wake of decreased travel and uncertain federal intervention," said Andrew Challenger, senior vice president at Challenger, Gray & Christmas. "An increasing number of companies that initially had temporary job cuts or furloughs are now making them permanent."

The coronavirus pandemic is still battering the US labor market. According to the latest Labor Department data, seasonally adjusted initial claims for jobless benefits for the week ending August 29 stood at 881,000. While it is around 130,000 down from the previous week's totals, it is only the second time the number of new jobless claims dropped below 1 million since the pandemic hit in March.

U.S. Economy Suffers Sharpest Drop Ever As GDP Crashes Nearly 32% During Coronavirus Peak

In the worst plunge ever recorded, the US economy contracted by 31.7 percent in the second quarter at the height of the Covid-19 crisis, according to revised data released by the Bureau of Economic Analysis on Thursday.

The latest US gross domestic product (GDP) reading is slightly better than the estimate issued last month, when the agency said that the world's largest economy shrank at an annual rate of 32.9 percent in the April-June period.

Despite the upward revision, based on better than previously estimated private inventory investment and personal consumption expenditures (PCE), the GDP drop is still the sharpest on record. The previous worst quarterly drop since tracking began in 1947 was observed in the first three months of 1958, when GDP fell 10 percent on an annualized basis



In the worst plunge ever recorded, the U.S. economy contracted by 31.7 percent in the second quarter.

The plunge came as most business activities were paralyzed for weeks, and millions of Americans lost their jobs amid strict stayat-home orders to contain the spread of the deadly virus. Despite having the highest number of coronavirus infections, the US gradually lifted lockdowns, possibly paving the way for partial recovery in the next quarter.

However, there are concerns that a second wave of Covid-19 may come this fall, further disrupting the economy.

"The full economic effects of the Covid-19 pandemic cannot be quantified in the GDP estimate for the second quarter of 2020 because the impacts are generally embedded in source data and cannot be separately identified," the Bureau of Economic Analysis (BEA) said. (Courtesy www.rt.com/business)

女性的变化及家庭

"近代家庭"是以专门从事家务劳动的主妇和专门工作挣钱的丈夫的组合而形成的一种性别角色分担型家庭。随着产业结构转换,女性进入职场,女性的选择增加,这样的家庭也随之出现变化。但双职工家庭也并没有达到使夫妻之间的性别角色分担弱化并改变丈夫在家庭内行为的程度,因此夫妻之间的权势关系仍属于传统型。

概括经济高度成长期以后女性的变化,可以 用"女性进入职场"这句话来表达。

据 1983 年发表的"昭和五十七年(1982年)就业结构基本调查",有配偶女子的就业比率为50.8%,终于超过了半数。在已婚妇女当中,"工作的主妇"超过"专业主妇","结婚以后就是家庭主妇"这种女性的人生历程,已转入少数派。

"女性进入职场"的实际情况并非一时曾非常流行的"走在潮流前面的、追求自由的女性""职业女性"的增加,而是经过婚育之后的女性劳动者的不稳定雇佣形态的增加,也就是出现了"女性劳动的周边化"(Marginalization of women's labor)现象。

"女性劳动的雇用形态变得多样化了",同时也是"不稳定化",比如非熟练部门的低工资、不稳定聘用等。由此我们可以指出,"女性进入职场"的重要内容是:(1)主要是婚育后女性的变化,(2)其实际情况是"女性劳动的周边化"。

1973年的石油危机以后,像日本和欧洲这样的资源小国兼先进工业国创造了数量庞大的女性就业机会,甚至成就了产业结构不景气时期的"高失业率下女性的雇佣机会增大"这一逆反命题。"高失业率"指的是全日制男性成年劳动者的失业率,而"女性雇佣机会的增大"是指对婚育后妇女的不稳定雇佣机会的增多。这并不构成巷谈街议所说的"女性占了男人的工作位置"。因为首先,女性从事的职业是以前所没有的成长产业的新职种;第二,女性从事的职种,条件极其恶劣,成年男子一般不

产业结构的转换直接冲击了熟练部门的中老年男性劳动者。产业结构转换期间女性雇佣机会的增多,是基于以下几个原因:(1)由于经济的软化,劳动的性别差异问题相对来说已不成为问题;(2)在服务部门,季节性和时间性变化大的非正规倒班的工作增多了;(3)那种"专

会从事这样的工种。

属女性的工作"以"兼职劳动"的形式产生了。 之所以这么说,是因为"那是女人的工作"。因 此,针对女性而新开辟出来的就业机会是成年男 性不可能从事的、工资低且工作不太稳定的"挣 零花钱的工作"(job for pin money)。

这种"女性劳动的周边化"也被逆命题地称为 "劳动的主妇化"(housewifezation of labor)。 女性生命历程类型的多样化

这种"女性进入职场"的实际情况,对女性 来说并不一定就是一种受欢迎的变化。

仅局限于那些有雇佣经验的、已婚并有孩子的女性来看,可以把她们围绕事业和家庭的生活

的女性来看,可以把她们围绕事业和家庭的生活 历程的选择归纳为以下三种类型:一直持续工作型、中断一再就业型、专业主妇型。 一直持续工作型,在30多岁的同时期出生的

一直持续工作型,在30岁岁的同时期出生的群体中所占比例大约为14%,并没有上升多少。与此相对,专业主妇型呈减少趋势。在80年代中期,日本劳动者家庭中的夫妻双收入的比率突破了60%。在这20年当中,从几乎为零的存在飞跃到最大的多数派的,是中断一再就业型。现在四五十岁的女性,在经济高度成长期长大成人,当她们到婚育年龄而离开工作单位的时候,并没有预想到将来会重新回到工作单位。经济的重组使女性的雇佣机会剧增是之后20年的事情。

好性的催佣机会剧增定之后20年的事情。 婚育期离职还是继续上班;孩子独立之后,母亲是重新回到工作单位还是留在家里,女性面临这两次抉择时,起作用的变量中有本人的学历、自立意识、家庭结构等各种各样的因素,最终起决定作用的是"丈夫的经济收入"这一经济因素。女性出去做兼职的最大动机是"贴补家用"也说明了这一点。但是另一方面,由于使妻子维持被抚养家庭成员地位的收入上限是"90万日元这一壁垒"(从1989年起上升到100万日元),这种"补贴家用"的收入还不到家庭年收入的25%。

同时,女性的高学历并不一定与有职业率成正比。在有高攀择偶(hypergamy)倾向的日本,大学学历的女性大都与有大学学历的男性结婚。由于高学历男性多数属于经济富裕的阶层,结果就出现了高学历女性中"无业妻子"增多的趋势。

继续工作型女性当中从事专业职种的女性居 多。日本女性的三大专职是保育员、教师和护士 这样的半专业职种,公务员也是一种。从事专业 职种的条件是高学历,然而,基本趋势是这些女 性大都与从事相同职业的男性或同行结婚,也就 是奉行同行结婚。但是女性容易继续工作的职场 以及"男女同工同酬"的职种,反过来从男性的 角度来看,是那些男性的工资控制在与女性相同 水平的职场。在公务员和教师当中,因结婚或生 孩子而离职的人很少,这不仅仅是因为她们具备 诸如育儿休假制度这样的容易继续工作的条件, 还有因为她们不能缩小靠两人全职工作所得的双 份工资才得以维持家庭生计之规模这样的实情。

.负才侍以维持家庭生计之规模这样的头情。 不仅"丈夫的收入"这一流量因素,而且

"父母的资产" 这一存量 因素也非常相关的。据这 个调查,要成为专业主妇 型的条件还列有"夫家的 资产"。如果夫家父母的 家底很厚,那么家庭的可 支配所得就增加。另一方 面,支持就业继续型的, 是"妻子娘家的资产"这 一条件。首先,为了使女 儿拥有能够从事专业职种 之学历,其生育家庭若非 已经属于学历非常高的家 庭,就是经济条件非常优 裕的家庭。第二,妻子娘 家富裕的家境可以为女儿

结婚以后的家庭,提供看得到或看不到的援助。包括接受妻子娘家的实物或者现金的援助在内, 甚至出现了把这样的家庭称为"三种收入"的词 汇用法。

因此,专业主妇型,是丈夫的流量和存量条件均很优沃的经济阶层的女性,就业继续型为妻子出身资产存量方面很富裕的家庭,通过与丈夫的双份收入而获得流量的阶层。中断一再就业型属于在存量和流量方面都不富裕的阶层。

如果仅从经济因素来谈论女性就业,我们就 面对以下煞风景的现实:不得不工作的人都很认 真地工作着,不工作就可以度日的人则不工作。 女性阶层的分化和家庭及生活文化的多样化

"复归职场的女性"和"停留在家庭的女性"的划分,实际上是经济阶层的划分这一点已经很明显。停留在家庭的"专业主妇"常常为"专业交际主妇",属于高过平均值的高学历、高经济阶层,保障主妇外出走动的条件是时间资源和金钱资源。

女性的这种变化必然会带来家庭次文化的分化。在"结婚以后就成为家庭主妇"这种生命历程已不再是唯一选择的今天,现实生活因女性的选择而大大地发生了改变。

女性的生命历程已经多样化,在就业继续型、中断一再就业型、专业主妇型这三种基本类型及其变化类型的范围内进展。这种分化的决定因素主要是经济因素——即女性的阶层归属。而决定女性的阶层归属的因素,除了上面提到的"丈夫的收入",再加上"妻子的收入"之外,"丈夫或者妻子,或者双方父母家的资产"也是影响因素。虽然这种说法免不了会被批判为经济还原主义,但是很遗憾,夫妻双方的经济实力是影响夫妻之间的力量关系和相互依存关系的最强因素,这一点确为事实。

如果妻子一方的流出和储存变大,那么,原本就属于双系的日本家庭结构,或许其母系志向会更强。和女儿同住愿望的强化、城市型母系同居的增加等等都显示了这种倾向。而且,妻子有独立收入这件事情并不一定会弱化夫妻间的相互



依存关系。为了维系以妻子的收入为前提才得以 形成的家计规模,家庭的凝聚力会增强的事实也 在情理之中。此外,随着夫家或妻子娘家资产价 值的上升,作为为保全资产的共同体的家庭凝聚 力非但没有减弱,反而强化了。这种凝聚力很强 的家庭被看作不以血缘连接的直系家庭而是以利 益连接的家庭,被称为"利系家庭"。

具体来说,夫妻和家庭的生活文化因妻子属于前述三种不同类型而相当不同。可以说现在的有职业主妇和无职业主妇各自的生活结构和生活时间,因它们属于不同的生态系统而很不相同。不仅她们出入的时间段和空间有偏离,甚至在围绕家长会和垃圾处理的需求和利害上她们之间还会出现对立。在家计支出方面,有职业女性的交际费和通信交通费的比例会大一点,而且在消费行为上也会有所不同。另外对家务劳动合理化的意识以及优先顺序的确定方法也不尽相同。

首先,不同类别的女性对配偶的期待和选择条件有很大的不同。专业主妇型的女性期望丈夫的经济实力,而继续就业型的女性则期待丈夫参与家务劳动。根据今村安的"日本主妇"的调查,主妇在期待和角色一致时感到一种"幸福感"(国际女性学会编,1978)。从这个意义上来说,期待就业志向很高的妻子成为家庭主妇的丈夫,以及反过来妻子非常想成为全职主妇而丈夫却没有相应经济实力的这两种不相配的婚姻,就成为"不幸感"的源泉。问题在于与女性的多样化

相适应的男性多样化有没有发生这一点上。 因此,一个家庭的生活文化——兴趣、业余时间的利用、有没有主要以夫妻为单位的行动模式、是否以孩子为中心、消费行为等等——都会随着妻子属于前述不同类型而大有不同。

"近代家庭"是以专门从事家务劳动的主妇和专门工作挣钱的丈夫的组合而形成的一种性别角色分担型家庭,其生活文化应该成为多样化家庭文化中的次类型的一种。
