# Trump signs budget deal after raising government shutdown threat

WASHINGTON (Reuters) - U.S. President Donald Trump signed Congress' newly passed \$1.3 trillion spending bill on Friday, ending several hours of confusion spurred by a tweeted veto threat that raised the specter of a government shutdown. Trump said he had signed the bill, despite his qualms on some issues, because a \$60 billion increase in military spending had convinced him it was a worthwhile compromise.

"But I say to Congress I will never sign another bill like this again," he told reporters. "I'm not going to do it again."

White House and Capitol Hill aides had been left scrambling earlier in the day after Trump criticized the six-month spending bill, despite prior assurances from the administration that he would sign it ahead of a looming midnight deadline.

"I am considering a VETO of the Omnibus Spending Bill based on the fact that the 800,000 plus DACA recipients have been totally abandoned by the Democrats (not even mentioned in Bill) and the BORDER WALL, which is desperately needed for our National Defense, is not fully funded," Trump wrote on Twitter at 9 a.m. EDT. But by early afternoon, he appeared before reporters in the Diplomatic Reception Room of the White House to announce he had signed the measure.

"There are a lot of things I'm unhappy about in this bill," he said, patting the more than 2,000 pages of the legislation stacked on a

purple box beside him. It was unclear how seriously Republican leaders took Trump's shutdown threat. Neither Speaker Paul Ryan nor Senate Leader Mitch McConnell commented publicly on it. REUTERS/Kevin Lamarque Lawmakers in the Republican-dominated Senate and House of Representatives had already left Washington for a scheduled twoweek spring recess, and Trump himself was scheduled on Friday to fly to Florida for a weekend at his private resort. Trump has been frustrated that Congress has

not turned over funding to make good on his campaign promise to build a wall along the U.S.-Mexico border. The bill includes \$1.6 billion for six month's of work on the project but he had sought \$25 billion for it. Trump also has been at odds with Democrats in Congress over the fate of Dreamer immigrants - those brought to the United States illegally when they were children.

Trump canceled the Deferred Action for Childhood Arrivals (DACA) program that

gives work permits to the Dreamers and protects them from deportation. The decision is currently tied up in court cases.

He offered to extend the protections, tied to a sweeping set of changes to immigration laws, but subsequently rejected bipartisan offers from lawmakers.

As the six-month spending budget deal was

coming together, there had been reports Trump had balked at the bill and had to be persuaded by Ryan to support it.

The conservative wing of Trump's party had panned the bill because of its spending increases and some deficit hawks cheered Trump's Friday morning threat to veto it.

### U.S. stock market cheerleader-in-chief goes quiet in downturn

LONDON (Reuters) - Investors have long toasted the U.S. stock market boom that emerged from the depths of the 2008 financial crisis, but one of the bull market's most vocal and visible cheerleaders has abruptly fallen silent: the U.S. President.

Since his inauguration in January last year, Donald Trump has regularly taken to Twitter to proclaim the gains in U.S. stocks, often appearing to take credit for their rise.

Following his surprise victory in November 2016, investors make a beeline for the market in what became known as the 'Trumpflation' trade - a bet that the former real estate mogul's administration would deliver a boost to the U.S. economy through increased fiscal spending, deregulation and tax cuts.

As the following graphic shows, the frequency of Trump's tweets touting the stock market upswing increased towards the second half of 2017 as the S&P 500, a broad index of U.S. stock prices, hit a series of record highs. The index ended the year up nearly 20 percent, its best annual performance since 2012.

## China slaps tariff on U.S. oil pipe, potential hit to

Texas industry

WASHINGTON - Texas manufacturers who produce steel oil and gas pipelines and drill pipe could take a hit after China announced it was slapping a 15 percent tariff on steel pipe from the United States.

"There is definitely a fair amount of the pipe manufacturing that gets done here," said Praveen Kumar, executive director of the University of Houston's Gutierrez Energy Management Institute. "It makes sense. Some of the biggest [steel pipe] buyers are in the Houston area, like Schlumberger, and the pipeline companies."

The tariffs are part of a sprawling \$3 billion tariff imposed by the Chinese early Friday, in response to President Donald Trump's announcement he would enact tariffs targeting \$50 billion in Chinese goods. Among the goods targeted by the Chinese are pork, apples and steel pipe. Now Playing: International reaction to Trump's

Donald Trump's decision to impose tariffs on steel and aluminium imports has fuelled fears of an escalating trade war and hit hard the share prices of Asian steelmakers and manufacturers supplying US markets.

Pipeline manufacturing has grown in Texas over the past decade, as the hydraulic fracturing boom took off in shale plays like the Eagle Ford and Permian Basin.

In November, global steel pipe giant Tenaris began production of steel oil and gas pipe at its new \$1.8 billion mill in Bay City, destined for shale oil and gas wells in Texas, Oklahoma and beyond. But a relatively small amount of that pipe goes to China. U.S. steel pipe exports reached 832,000 metric tons last year, according to the U.S. International Trade Administration. More than 80 percent of that

pipe went to Canada and Mexico, with China coming in a distant third. "Bottom line, if the retaliation is on pipelines, Houston will not see much

## Total U.S. drilling rig count inches toward 1,000

West Texas' booming Permian Basin led another jump in the number of rigs drilling for oil as the overall rig count inches toward 1,000 for the first time in nearly three years.

to the oil patch while one rig was tacked onto natural gas fields, according to weekly data collected by Baker Hughes, a GE company. The overall U.S. rig count is now up to 995 rigs, including 804 of them drilling for oil.

Both Texas and the Permian added seven rigs, more than offsetting a loss of four rigs in Oklahoma. No other region of the country had a sizable gain or loss during the week.

The Permian alone now accounts for 444 oil rigs - 55 percent of the oil rig count nationwide. Likewise, Texas is home to 499 total rigs -This week saw four net rigs added more than half of the nation's total.

The overall rig count, including oil and gas rigs, has sat below 1,000 since April 2015 when oil prices were collapsing.

U.S. oil prices were hovering above \$65 a barrel early Friday afternoon. The last time oil prices were \$67 or higher was December 2014. After the Permian, the next most active area is South Texas' Eagle Ford shale with 72 rigs. Oklahoma's


Cana Woodford is next with 59 rigs. Oklahoma is still home to the second-most rigs with 120 active. New Mexico is next with 88 rigs. The total U.S. rig count is well up from an all-time low of 404 rigs in May 2016.

Despite this week's jump, the oil rig count is down 50 percent from its peak of 1,609 in October 2014, before oil prices began plummeting. at the Harvard Club, a private social club in Boston. This year, attendees came from 70 countries and featured 500 speakers.





Furthermore, he's quick to point out the conflicts of interest regarding physicians and vaccines. See my August 2017 article "The Unknown Reasons Doctors Push Vaccines. However, the most humbling of personality traits Dr. Neides possesses is his genuine remorse for not knowing about vaccines and the harms he inadvertently may have caused patients. He apologizes profusely in the video below, which is very humbling to see and hear-a medical doctor remorseful for not knowing what he should have known to be able to prevent health harms to patients.




