Citing climate differences, Shell walks away from U.S. refining lobby

LONDON (Reuters) - Royal Dutch Shell Plc on Tuesday became the first major oil and gas company to announce plans to leave a leading U.S. refining lobby due to disagreement on climate policies.

In its first review of its association with 19 key industry groups, the company said it had found "material misalignment" over climate policy with the American Fuel & Petrochemical Manufacturers (AFPM) and would quit the body in 2020.

The review is part of Shell's drive to increase transparency and show investors it is in line with the 2015 Paris climate agreement's goals to limit global warming by reducing carbon emissions to a net zero by the end of the century.

It is also the latest sign of how investor pressure on oil companies, particularly in Europe, is leading to changes in their behavior around climate. Last year, Shell caved in to investor pressure over climate change, setting out plans to introduce industry-leading carbon emissions targets linked to executive pay.

Its chief executive, Ben van Beurden, has since repeatedly urged oil and gas producers to take action over climate and pollution, staking out a more radical position than the heads of other major oil companies.

"AFPM has not stated support for the goal of the Paris Agreement. Shell supports the goal of the Paris Agreement," the Anglo-Dutch company said in its decision.

"The need for urgent action in response to climate change has become ever more obvious since the signing of the Paris Agreement in 2015. As a result, society's expectations in this area have changed, and Shell's views have also evolved," van Beurden said in the report.

The company has disagreed with AFPM on a number of issues for some time, according to two lobbying sources. Shell said it also disagreed with AFPM's opposition to a price on carbon and action on low-carbon technologies.

Shell and AFPM have also been at odds in recent months over regulation over the use of renewable fuels. While Shell and other large refiners invested in cleaner fuel technology, AFPM has fought hard against standards requiring refiners to blend or subsidize the blending of biofuels into the gasoline pool - saying it hurts independent refiners.

Shell and rivals Exxon and BP have in recent years also left the American Legislative Exchange Council, a conservative political group, over its stance on climate change.

AFPM Chief Executive Chet Thompson thanked Shell for its "long-standing collaboration."

"We will also continue working on behalf of the refining and petrochemical industries to advance policies that ensure reliable and affordable access to fuels and petrochemicals, while being responsible stewards of the environment," Thompson said in a statement.

AFPM counts around 300 U.S. and international members including Exxon Mobil Corp , Chevron Corp , BP Plc and Total SA that operate 110 refineries and 229 petrochemical plants, according to its 2018 annual report. Shell's review was welcomed by Adam Matthews, director of ethics and engagement for the Church of England Pensions Board, which invests in Shell and led discussions with the company over its climate policy.

"This is an industry first," Matthews said.
"With this review Shell have set the benchmark for best practice on corporate climate lobbying not just within oil and gas but across all industries.
The challenge now is for others to follow suit."

WALK AWAY

Shell also found "some" misalignment with nine other trade associations, including the American Petroleum Institute, the oil and gas industry's main

Shell said that while it had some climate-related differences with API, it welcomed the lobby's advocacy on a range of state and federal issues such as trade and transport, as well as the API's efforts to reduce methane emissions.

One dead in fire at KMCO chemi-

cal plant in Crosby

One person has died and two people were critically injured in a fire Tuesday morning at KMCO chemical plant in Crosby, authorities

The fire at the plant at 16503 Ramsey Road has been contained and responders are working to prevent it from spreading to nearby tanks, Rachel Moreno, a spokesperson for the Harris County Fire Marshal's Office, said at a news conference Tuesday afternoon.

The two people who were injured have been taken by helicopter ambulance to the hospital in critical condition, Moreno said.

A shelter in place has been ordered for all residents within a 1-mile radius of the plant.

Several campuses, including Crosby ISD, Channelview ISD, Galena Park ISD and Sheldon ISD had ordered a shelter in place. Crosby ISD has turned off their HVAC systems.

Crosby ISD ended its shelter-in-places for all campuses but the Crosby Kindergarten Center at about 1:50 p.m. The Kindergarten Center is located within 1 mile of the plant and remains closed.

In a Facebook post, the district said students at the Kindergarten Center are not yet allowed to be picked up, and students who ride buses but live within a one-mile radius of the fire will be transported back to their campus and held there until a parent or guardian can pick them up. The district will not enter the one-mile radius zone with students on board, the post said.

Houston ISD canceled all outdoor activities Tuesday afternoon at the following campuses located in the northeast portion of the district: Robinson, Oates, Hilliard and Elmore elementary schools; Furr and North Forest high schools; and Fon-

containing isobutylene, a type of colorless gas, ignited, spreading the fire to a warehouse, authorities said Tuesday.

KMCO contractors Brian Balcerowicz and Cesar Mendoza were in the control room when the explosion happened about 10:55 a.m.. That meant they were just a couple of feet away from danger, the former observed.

All campuses in Crosby ISD and Sheldon ISD are under a shelter in place. Crosby ISD has turned off their HVAC systems and it will not release students to parents or let them onto school buses until further notice.

"They said there had been a problem and stay in the control room," Balcerowicz said. "About five minutes later we heard and felt the explosion."

The operator then told everyone to leave the premises. Balcerowicz noted that the control room was a safe place since it was explosion-proof. KMCO OWNERS: What we now about the com-


and CEO John C. Foley said in a statement. "We are deeply saddened to confirm at this time that there have been injuries and one fatality," Foley said. "Those injured have been transported for medical treatment. Our hearts and prayers go out to the individuals involved, as well as our first responders, employees, and our community." Corey Prantil, 31, felt his house shake at about 10:55 Tuesday morning.

From his location about two and a half miles northeast of the KMCO plant, the ground shook, his windows rattled and it sounded like someone was trying to break in through the front door.



In a stunning about-face, State Department officials said that President Donald Trump is cutting off all direct assistance to the so-called Northern Triangle countries of El Salvador, Honduras and Guatemala. "At the Secretary's instruction, we are carrying out the President's direction and ending FY [fiscal year] 2017 and FY 2018 foreign assistance programs for the Northern Triangle," a State Department spokesperson told ABC News, referring to U.S. Secretary of State Mike Pompeo. "We will be engaging Congress as part of this process." These three countries are the primary source of migrants to the U.S., but for years the U.S. has worked with them to stabilize their political environments and economies and end violence and corruption so that migrants wouldn't leave in the first place. Trump hinted at the cuts earlier on Friday, telling reporters,"I've ended payments to

While the president has threatened these cuts before, this time the administration is actually following through.

dor. No money goes there anymore."

Pence to immigrants: 'If you can't come legally, don't come at all'

Homeland Security Secretary Kirstjen Nielsen was in Mexico and Honduras this week meeting with their leadership to sign new partnership agreements. Pompeo testified before the House of Representatives on Wednesday about the administration's efforts, saying the president had instructed him and Nielsen to use U.S. funding to "develop a set of programs that reward effective outcomes, that reward good leadership, that get us to a place

where we actually achieve the outcomes." In a speech in Brazil last June, Vice President Mike Pence touted the "significant resources" the administration was putting toward this effort, though much of those resources were allocated under former President Barack Obama's administration.

"The United States of America has never been more committed to strengthening our partnership with the nations in the Northern Triangle to help ... tackle the problems facing our shared neighborhood," Pence said in October when hosting leaders from the Northern Triangle and Mexico at the State Department with Pompeo. Trump's previous threats to pull the plug, however, had often left U.S. officials scratching their heads and straining to explain why these funds described as key to stemming migration would be cut off -- as punishment for not stemming migration. When Pompeo was challenged on the president's previous threatening tweets on Wednesday, he told Congress, "I'm not going to comment on my evaluation. You asked me about the U.S. policy, and I've done my level-best to articulate it." (Courtesy abcnews.com)

The aid affects about \$500 million in 2018 funds and several millions more from the prior fiscal year, officials said. The money goes toward programs that address violence, poverty and employment.

On Friday, President Donald Trump took to Twitter, threatening to close the border, or at least stretches of it, next week if Mexican officials don't "stop illegals from entering the U.S."

A congressional delegation visiting El Salvador on Saturday said in a statement they were "extremely disappointed" about the fund cutoff and said they plan to "push back."
