Wall Street Week Ahead: Data will show damage of tariffs, strong dollar on U.S. goods exporters



NEW YORK (Reuters) - It's no longer a probability, it's a reality: the escalating U.S.-China trade war and the strengthening dollar appear to be inflicting measurable damage on U.S. goods makers that rely on global markets.

Market participants will get a picture of the extent to which trade tensions and currency have hurt U.S. manufacturers when the Institute for Supply Management (ISM) releases its purchasing managers index (PMI) USPMI=ECI for September on Tuesday.

Its August report showed the manufacturing sector, which accounts for about 12% of the U.S. economy, contracting in for the first time in 3-1/2 years, and more worryingly, its export component hit a more than 10-year low.

"The exporters are at least a half a step or full step closer to the predicted recession," said Robert Pavlik, chief investment strategist, senior portfolio manager at SlateStone Wealth LLC in New York.

The August report's New Export Orders plunged to 43.3, its lowest level since April 2009, when the United States was in the throes of the great recession.

A PMI reading below 50 indicates contraction.

In the August PMI survey, manufacturers told ISM "business is starting to show signs of a broad slowdown," and that "tariffs continue to be a strain on the supply chain and the economy overall."

China already has implemented tariffs on about \$110 billion in U.S. goods, in return for President Donald Trump's tariffs on Chinese imports. Beijing announced additional retaliatory increases in August. The first tranche took effect at the beginning of this month and the second is due to follow on Dec. 15.

U.S. goods would already be more expensive on global markets due to a stronger dollar, which has been boosted by simmering geopolitical unease and negative interest rates in Europe. Market-rattling tit-for-tat tariff hikes from Washington and Beijing have created a perfect storm.

"Geopolitical tensions do two things," said Peter Tuz, president of Chase Investment Counsel in Charlottesville, Virginia. "They compel big companies to sit back and not spend as much as they would."

"And as tensions increase and the dollar rises, (U.S.) products become more expensive and you see demand fall off."

The dollar index .DXY, which measures the greenback against a basket of major world currencies, hit a 29-month high on Sept. 3, the very day ISM released its dismal PMI report.

Indeed, in the first quarter of 2018, during which Trump fired the opening salvo in the trade war, the negative currency impact on North

American corporate earnings was an estimated \$40 million, according to cloud treasury services firm Kyriba.

One year later, that number ballooned to \$23.4 billion.

The arrival of third-quarter earnings season next month will provide a clearer view of the damage the trade war and strong dollar have wrought on companies' bottom lines.

Over the last year, third-quarter analyst earnings estimates for a basket of 15 top U.S. exporters by dollar value have dropped by an average of 17.3%, according to Refinitiv data, and by 12.3% in the last three months.

Fourth-quarter estimates for the same companies have been revised down 15.6% on average since September 2018 by 10.3% since June.

Third-quarter earnings estimates for Apple Inc (AAPL.O) are 7.4% lower than they were a year ago, and down 16.7% for the essential October-December holiday quarter. Non-U.S. revenue contributes 63.1% of the iPhone

maker's total.

General Electric Co (GE.N) gets about 61.5% of its revenue from abroad. Analysts currently see the conglomerate's third-quarter earnings coming in 44.6% below the level seen a year ago, and its fourth-quarter EPS estimates are now 43.5% lower.

Chipmakers, particularly vulnerable to trade concerns and technology exchange issues, have seen their earnings estimates slashed most.

Micron Technology Inc MU.N relies on non-U.S. business for 88.1% of its revenue. Third quarter earnings estimates for the company have plunged 83.4% over the last year and 42% from last quarter.

Overseas customers contribute 97.4% of Qualcomm Inc's (QCOM.O) revenue. Analysts have slashed their third quarter earnings estimates for the company by 47.7% over the last year.

Nike Inc (NKE.N), which derives 62.5% of its revenues from overseas, reported its first-quarter earnings for fiscal year 2020 on Tuesday. The sportswear company's revenue and profit beat analyst estimates, but it said currency and trade concerns remained headwinds and it expects the impact of tariffs will be "most pronounced" in the current quarter.

"The manufacturing side of our economy is in the early stages of a recession and we should be concerned about the possibility of a full recession spreading here and around the world," said Tim Ghriskey, chief investment strategist at Inverness Counsel in New York.

"If (the ISM PMI) export number remains weak that will point to deepening overseas weakness," Ghriskey added. "But a strong number would surprise me given what's happening around the world."

House Democrats subpoena Pompeo for Ukraine documents

WASHINGTON (Reuters) - Democrats in the U.S. House of Representatives who are pursuing an impeachment inquiry against President Donald Trump forged ahead with their probe on Friday, issuing a subpoena to Secretary of State Mike Pompeo for documents concerning contact with the Ukrainian government.

Following a whistleblower complaint that Trump, a Republican, solicited a political favor from Ukraine's president that could help him get re-elected, the lawmakers are investigating concerns that Trump's actions have jeopardized national security and the integrity of U.S. elections.

The House Foreign Affairs, Intelligence and Oversight Committees also scheduled depositions for five State Department officials over the next two weeks, including Kurt Volker, Trump's envoy to Ukraine. Volker resigned his post on Friday, according to sources familiar with the matter.

The reason for Volker's resignation was not immediately known. The State Department did not immediately respond to a request for comment on the subpoena or Volker's resignation.

The committees announced the subpoena after the Trump administration missed a Thursday deadline to provide documents and information about contacts with Ukrainian officials, as well as a July 25 telephone call between Trump and Ukrainian President Volodymyr Zelenskyy.

That call is central to the impeachment investigation that Nancy Pelosi, the speaker of the Democratic-led House, announced this week.

The impeachment inquiry has cast a new pall over Trump's presidency just months after he emerged from the shadow cast by Special Counsel Robert Mueller's investigation into whether he colluded with Russia in the 2016 election.

Trump has reacted furiously to the impeachment inquiry, arguing he did nothing wrong, and accusing Democrats of launching a politically motivated "witch hunt."

More than 300 former national security officials from both Republican and Democratic administrations on Friday endorsed the impeachment inquiry, saying they did not prejudge the outcome but wanted to know more facts.

TRUMP DOUBLES DOWN

As the subpoena was announced, Trump's re-election campaign said it would spend \$10 million next week airing an ad called "Biden corruption" on television and websites that accuses Democrats of playing politics with the impeachment investigation.

Former Democratic Vice President Joe

Biden is Trump's leading rival in the race for the 2020 presidential election.

The White House this week released a summary of Trump's July 25 phone call in which he asked Zelenskyy to investigate Biden and his son Hunter Biden ahead of the November 2020 presidential election - a call at the heart of the whistleblower's complaint.

Hunter Biden served on the board of a Ukrainian gas company called Burisma when Biden was in office. There has been no evidence that the former vice president used his position to help his son in the Ukraine matter.

Ukraine's anti-corruption investigation agency said on Friday it was investigating permits given to companies managed by Burisma during 2010-2012. Hunter Biden was hired in 2014. The agency said it would only go further if compelling new testimony emerged.

The whistleblower raised concerns about interactions that Trump's personal lawyer Rudolph Giuliani - who has promoted theories about Biden's activities in Ukraine - had with former and current Ukrainian officials.



Discussions Focused On Plans For The Upcoming Texas-African Business Summit

President Alpha Condé Of The Republic of Guinea Visited Houston And Southern News

On September 16, 2019, President Alpha Condé, President of the Republic of Guinea and former Chairperson of the African Union Guinea, led 23 ministers from Guinea to visit Southern News Group in Houston to discuss the upcoming Texas-African Business Summit. Chairman of the Texas-Africa Business Summit, Chairman of the Houston International Trade Center, President of the International District of Houston and Chairman of Southern News Group and Founder of the Texas-Africa Business Summit, Wea H. In 1988, he was renamed the Guinean People's Union and served as the party chairman. He was elected to the National Assembly in 1995 and was arrested by the authorities during the 1998 election and sentenced to 10 years in prison.



Gezhagen Kebede, Honorary Consul General of Ethiopia in Houston and Co-Chairman of the Houston International Trade Center, introduced the President of the Republic of Guinea, Alpha Conde, to the luncheon guests. Released in advance in 2001, he immediately fled to France. After the coup in Guinea in 2008, he returned to the moth-

erland. He has twice participated in the presidential election, and was elected president in November 2010, re-elected on October 17, 2015, and re-elected on December 21, 2015 to serve as president of the Republic of Guinea. On January 30, 2017, he was elected as the Head of the African Union.

Chairman Wea H Lee gave a welcome speech. He warmly welcomed the former Chairperson of the African Union and current President of the Republic of Guinea, Alpha Condé, and invited him to visit Houston and visit the International Trade Center. Chairman Lee pointed out that the United States is a multi-ethnic and multi-cultural country. "African-Americans are also an important part of our great country. Our International Trade Center and African Americans have long-term cooperation and have made great achievements in many projects. We also hope to have long-term cooperation with various countries in Africa in the future, which is why we will hold the third Texas-Africa Business Summit in September next year."

President Alpha Condé is also the former Chairperson of the African Union and also provides an opportunity for Texas-Africa business cooperation. Africa is the second largest continent on the planet with more than 1 billion people. It has

56 countries and has more diverse African culture and language than anywhere else in the world. The economy is quite backward, and the level of economic development and material living standards needs to be improved. Prosperous and peaceful Africa is a driving force on the global stage. Africa's economic development is crucial to Africa's strategic interests and the strategic interests of the United States.

Chairman Lee went on to explain that, "We are planning to hold the third Texas-Africa Business Summit at Rice University, bringing together government and business leaders from the US and the African continent. Conde pointed out that his government attaches importance to increasing water and electricity supply in major cities and vigorously developing agriculture. He pointed out that Houston has abundant funds, advanced technology and many development projects. Why it matters: That still leaves more than half of the almost 2,000-mile border uncovered, and there are gaps and dilapidated fencing in the barriers that are in place. The fight that has shut down the government is basically about 234 miles of new border wall that President Trump wants, according to the Trump administration's latest request.

By the numbers: Less than half of the border between the U.S. and Mexico has man-made barriers, according to Reveal News.

•**Only 403 miles** of fencing is intended to keep out pedestrians, while the rest just keeps out vehicles, according to a study by the Federation for American Immigration Reform, an immigration group that advocates for lowering immigration levels.

•**For 36 miles**, there is a second tier of pedestrian fencing.

•**And for 14 miles**, there are three layers of fencing.

•**In October**, the Department of Homeland Security unveiled the 2.5-mile-long, 30-foot-tall steel slatted barrier in Calexico, California, dubbing it the first completed border wall project — despite the fact that it just replaced existing fencing.

• **The border also** runs through the rugged,

mountainous terrain of Big Bend National Park for 118 miles. Many local government officials fear that a wall would negatively impact wildlife and look bad in the beautiful park, NPR has reported.



•**62 miles** of the border are part of the Tohono O'odham Nation reservation in Arizona. The nation has historic ties to Mexico as well as current tribe members there, and they'd be further cut off from each other if a wall was built, according to USA Today.

Trump wants \$5.7 billion to build new steel barriers along 234 miles of the south-

ern border, according to the latest letter sent by the White House to Senate Appropriations Committee Chairman Richard Shelby earlier this month.

•**Details:** The priority would be to build a barrier along 104 miles in the Rio Grande Valley, which is a popular crossing point and has few barriers, Vox's Dara Lind reported. Next, the administration would focus on putting up barriers in a 27-mile stretch in Yuma, Arizona; 14 miles in El Centro, California; and 55 miles in Laredo, Texas.

•**What to watch:** The government would have to use its powers of eminent domain to take private land from Americans at the border to build the wall — something that would likely spark a flurry of legal battles. Around 100 Texans have already received letters from the government asking for access to their land to look at how and where a wall could be built, the Washington Post reported.



Background: Trump has often changed his mind about the wall, at one point pitching Republicans that it could be covered in solar panels, another time insisting that it be "see-through," claiming it would be "artistically designed steel slats," and then insisting that "an all concrete Wall was NEVER ABANDONED."

•**He's changed his budget** requests from \$25 billion to \$18 billion to \$5 billion over the past year. But DHS only asked for \$1.6 billion to build 65 miles worth of barriers in its 2019 budget request. The latest Trump administration proposal is an effort to expand that request.

The bottom line: Securing the rest of the border would be a huge challenge under the best political conditions. After the longest government shutdown in history, it's going to be even tougher. (Courtesy axios.com)

《中國機長》不是“薩利機長”山寨版

張涵予讓劉傳健機長“放心” 歐豪杜江與原型重聚

川航“英雄機長”劉傳健、第二機長梁鵬和副駕駛徐瑞辰，昨日出席《中國機長》首映，並與張涵予、歐豪和杜江同臺交流。電影出品人於冬稱拍攝《中國機長》是完成了壹個“不可能完成的任務”，絕不要觀眾認為這是山寨版《薩利機長》。

於冬首次講述了影片籌備初期的背後故事，他透露，川航3U8633緊急備降成都事件本身已經足夠震撼，看到新聞資料的時候就有把它拍成電影的沖動：“後來又看了劉傳健機長的採訪，強烈的敬畏之心促使我要把這個電影拍出來。但我也知道這事兒沒這麼簡單。”於是他直直等到了去年9月，事件調查有了初步結果，電影的籌備工作才正式開始啓動。

然而，無論是故事本身還是題材

，加上不到壹年的準備時間，對所有人來說都有著巨大的壓力，“題材聽起來不錯，真正做時候發現沒辦法拍，因為是個沒懸念的故事，全球皆知，不能誇大，只能充分去挖掘英雄機組和中國民航背後的故事。”

於冬還透露，為了呈現真實震撼的空中危機，導演劉偉強第壹時間去了洛杉磯，把所有做過飛機特效的後期公司都找了壹個遍，“這其中就包括當初給《薩利機長》做特效的公司，但《薩利機長》當時的特效並不多，而且如今距離那部電影問世也過去很多年了，他們的技術變得更加成熟，也更適合我們這部對特效有著超高要求的《中國機長》。”

在組成了壹個超強的制作團隊之後，接下來要解決的就是在哪裏拍攝

的問題。出於技術上的需求，主創團隊曾想過去國外拍攝，但很快就打消了這個念頭，因為“《中國機長》必須要在中國拍攝，才更加名正言順”。最終主創找到了中航工業西安飛機工業有限責任公司，用3個月的時間完成了壹架需要10個月才能做完的1:1原大、三段分離的模擬機。而與此同時，演員沒看到劇本就已經投入了訓練，民航各有關單位和英雄機組成員也都在全力配合影片的籌備工作。

電影裏的英雄機組有9名成員，而他們每個人都再現實裏對應著壹個原型人物。影片從開拍那天起，每壹天，每個演員都會跟原型通過微信和視頻聯繫，每壹句臺詞，每壹個動作都要跟原型溝通確認，而這壹切都是為了確保表演的準確和真實。

當天，四川航空3U8633航班的“英雄機長”劉傳健、第二機長梁鵬以及副駕駛徐瑞辰也來到現場。對於張涵予在片中飾演自己，劉傳健說了兩個字：“放心！”

第二機長梁鵬生性陽光開朗，杜江也笑稱：“之前梁機長說，我能在電影裏飾演他，他老婆也很開心。現在我想告訴梁機長，我這次能飾演您，我老婆也很開心。”

電影之前上映的時候放出了副駕駛徐瑞辰和歐豪的合影，觀眾都覺得兩個人太像了。雖然不是親兄弟，但兩人都是92年的，歐豪說：“我很開心我們90後有這樣壹個英雄，當時他受了那麼重的傷，但依然堅持完成全部工作後才下機，真正做到了‘敬畏生命，敬畏規章，敬畏責任’。”

此外，袁泉在《中國機長》中飾演乘務長畢男，她形容電影會把人帶入到壹個“手心冒汗，聚精會神，壹秒鐘也不願意錯過的觀影旅程”；張天愛則認為這部電影雖然驚險不斷，但依然是壹個有愛又讓人感覺到幸福的旅程；李沁透露自己的角色原型雖然受傷了但依然堅守崗位，所以這也是壹個堅守崗位的旅程，而自己也因為這部電影跟張天愛成了非常好的姐妹。

值得提提的是，《中國機長》北京首映當天正趕上北京大興國際機場正式投入運營，用中國民用航空宣傳教育中心主任馬松偉的話說就是“雙喜臨門”：“北京大興國際機場是我們的硬件建設，即將在全國上映的《中國機長》則是我們民航文化軟實力的體現。”

古天樂黑吃黑，還是全員都是嫌疑犯？

，人物海報直接展現了不同人物的情緒狀態。眼含淚光的楊見珊（薛凱琪飾）、目露兇光的歐陽正（姜皓文飾）、神情警惕的少梅（顏卓靈飾）等，他們又與“案中案”有何聯繫？電影《犯罪現場》在經典犯罪警匪類型片的呈現下，也對人性善惡兩面進行了深刻思考。有的時候，人性的善與惡僅有壹線之隔。

電影《犯罪現場》講述了心狠手辣的犯罪團夥頭目汪新元（古天樂飾）與同夥在壹場珠寶店搶劫案中造成多人傷亡。兩個月後，他的同黨被人割喉謀殺，慘死屋內。以分贓不均陷入內鬥為由，警察將汪新元列為頭號嫌疑人。隨著小警官林法梁（張繼聰飾）深入調查，發現案件真相並不簡單。犯罪警匪電影《犯罪現場》將於10月12日登陸全國院線。
