UK PM Johnson pressured on jail terms after London Bridge attack

LONDON (Reuters) - The London Bridge attack pushed law and order towards the top of the British political agenda on Saturday, with days to go before a snap election, after police said the assailant had previously been convicted of terrorism offences but freed early from jail.

Usman Khan, wearing a fake suicide vest and wielding knives, went on the rampage at a conference on criminal rehabilitation beside London Bridge on Friday, killing two people. The 28-year old Briton was wrestled to the ground by bystanders and then shot dead by police.

Police said on Saturday that Khan had been convicted in 2012 for his part in an al Qaeda-inspired plot to blow up the London Stock Exchange. He was released in December 2018 subject to conditions.

Jeremy Corbyn, leader of the main opposition Labour Party, criticized the government's sentencing policies.

"There's got to be a very full investigation," said Corbyn who is seeking to depose Prime Minister Boris Johnson in the election on Dec. 12 but trails in opinion polls.

"I think there is also a question about what the probation service were doing ... and whether the parole board should

have been involved in deciding whether or not he should have been allowed to be released from prison in the first place," he said.

Earlier, Johnson said the London Bridge attack was a terrorist act and vowed to end a practice whereby serious offenders can be automatically let out of prison early. "I have long said that this system simply isn't working," he said after visiting the scene of the attack on Saturday. Islamic State said the attack on Friday was carried out by one of its fighters and was in response to its calls to target countries that had been part of a coalition fighting the jihadist group, according to its Amaq news agency. The group did not provide any evidence for its assertion. A man and a woman were killed in the attack, with local media naming one of the victims as Jack Merritt, a course coordinator for Learning Together, a prisoners' rehabilitation program which held the conference at Fishmongers' Hall.

Three people remain in hospital with two victims in a stable condition while a third person is suffering from less serious injuries, according to the National Health Service.

ECHOES OF 2017

Police said they were continuing their investigation by searching an address in Stafford and the Stoke areas of central England, with the country's top counter-terrorism officer saying they were not looking for any other suspects.

"We have found no evidence to suggest anybody else was involved in this attack," said Neil Basu. "Our investigative priority at this time is to ensure that there is no related outstanding threat to the public."

London Bridge was the scene of an attack during the 2017 election when three militants drove a van into pedestrians and then attacked people in the surrounding area, killing eight people and injuring at least 48.

Islamic State said its fighters were responsible for that attack, but the British authorities have cast doubt on those claims. The 2017 attack focused attention on cuts to policing since the ruling Conservatives took power in 2010.

Friday's attack prompted a pause in election campaigning, but scaled-back activities resumed on Saturday, ahead of the election that could decide the fate of Brexit.

Law and order is now likely to feature more prominently in the campaign in the coming days.

The Conservatives could fail to win an overall majority during next month's election according to a BMG poll published on Saturday, conducted before the attack. It showed their lead over Labour had fallen to six points from 13 a week ago.

Hong Kong seniors rally to back students as activists decry police actions

HONG KONG (Reuters) - Secondary school students and retirees joined forces to protest in Hong Kong on Saturday, the first of several weekend rallies planned across the city...

"I came out for the peaceful protest in June when there was more than one million people, but the government did not listen to our demands," said a 71-year-old woman in Hong Kong's Central district who only gave her name as Ponn.

'FIVE DEMANDS' Demonstrators are angered by what they see as Chinese interference in freedoms promised when Britain returned Hong Kong to Beijing in 1997.

China denies interfering and says it is committed to the "one country, two systems" formula put in place in the Asian financial hub in 1997.

"They need to release the full CCTV footage of that night," said D. Wong, a 19-year-old protester holding up his laptop that was playing a film about perceived police brutality.

In the Kowloon Bay area, a few hundred protesters formed a line and stood side by side, holding hands.

On Saturday, citing authorities, the Communist party newspaper of the southern Chinese city of Guangzhou said police had arrested a Belize citizen for allegedly colluding with people in the United States to meddle in Hong Kong affairs.

The Number of Overweight People In The U.S. Has Increased Significantly in Recent Years

Obesity Greatly Increases Risk Of Serious Disease And Early Death, Warn Researchers

Being obese is linked to a significantly higher chance of serious disease and early death than being a healthy weight, research on more than 2.8 million adults suggests.

The chance of suffering serious illness goes up with increasing weight gain, experts analysing health, death and sickness data from UK adults found.

How much does the risk increase as your BMI rises?

Presented at the European Congress on Obesity (ECO) in Glasgow, the study found that people with a body mass index (BMI) of 30 to 35 were at 70% higher risk of developing heart failure than their healthy weight peers.

Even a BMI of 25 to 30 increased the risk by 20%, while a BMI of 35 to 40 more than doubled the risk and a BMI of 40 to 45 almost quadrupled the risk compared to people of a normal weight.

The study also found that compared with normal weight individuals, a BMI of 25 to 30 increased the risk of Type 2 diabetes and sleep apnoea by more than double, while a person with a BMI of 30 to 35 was more than five times as likely to develop Type 2 diabetes and almost six times as likely to develop sleep apnoea.

For those with a BMI of 35 to 40, the risk of Type 2 diabetes was almost nine times higher, and 12 times higher for sleep apnoea.



People with severe obesity (BMI of 40 to 45) were 12 times more likely to develop Type 2 diabetes and had a risk of sleep apnoea that was 22 times greater.

The results also showed that increasing weight was linked to higher risk of high blood pressure, irregular heartbeat and dyslipidaemia (abnormal levels of cholesterol and other fats in the blood).

To what degree?

People with a BMI of 40 to 45 had triple the risk of heart failure, high blood pressure, and dyslipidaemia.

This BMI was also linked to a 50% higher risk of dying prematurely from any cause compared to people of a normal weight.

The research found that the risk of developing serious health problems was highly dependent on whether or not people already had issues at the start of the study.


For example, having high blood pressure at the start of the study was strongly associated with developing dyslipidaemia, chronic kidney disease and Type 2 diabetes.

How extensive was the research?

Researchers looked at health, death and BMI data from more than 2.8 million adults between January 2000 and July 2018 from the UK Clinical Practice Research Datalink.

This was linked with hospital data to estimate the risk for serious health problems.

What do the report authors highlight from their work?

Author Christiane Haase, from Novo Nordisk in Denmark, which funded the study, said: "The health risks linked with having excess body weight are particularly high for Type 2 diabetes and sleep apnoea."

"With the number of people living with obesity almost tripling worldwide over the past 30 years (105 million people in 1975 to 650 million in 2016), our findings have serious implications for public health."

The research was presented as a poster at the conference and was peer-reviewed by the conference selection committee. Naveed Sattar, professor of metabolic medicine at the University of Glasgow, said: "This study serves to remind us, once again, how damaging obesity is given its strong associations with a range of conditions beyond diabetes and heart disease."

"The obesity links to heart failure are becoming more widely appreciated and links to sleep apnoea, hypertension and abnormal blood fats are well known."

"Like most observational BMI studies using routine health data, there are limitations to this work but I suspect some risks are in fact underestimated."

"The health profession needs to up its game in helping people improve their weight (there are good signs that it is doing so) as it is unlikely that the food environment is going to drastically improve anytime soon."



Who else has reacted to the report findings?

Dr Emily Burns, head of research communications at Diabetes UK, said: "It's important to note the significantly increased risk of Type 2 diabetes suggested by this research – while alarming – was specifically seen in people with a very high BMI of over 40, which only accounts for 2% of men and 5% of women in England."

"That said, we know that being overweight increases your risk of developing Type 2 diabetes."

"Losing weight can be tough, but programmes such as NHS England's Diabetes Prevention Programme are there to help people at high risk, and the Diabetes UK website has ideas for healthy meals, ingredient swaps and tips on getting active too."

Louis Levy, head of nutrition science at Public Health England (PHE), said: "Most countries are facing increasing levels of obesity, putting pressure on both individuals' health and national health and social care systems."

"To reverse what's been decades in the making needs sustained action across the drivers of poor diets and weight gain."

"We're working with industry to make food healthier, we've produced guidance for councils on planning healthier towns and we've delivered campaigns encouraging people to choose healthier food and lead healthier lives." (Courtesy https://www.itv.com/news)

1.2 Billion Records Found Exposed Online In A Single Server

Jumbo Data Leak Includes All Facebook, Twitter, And LinkedIn Profiles

For well over a decade, identity thieves, phishers, and other online scammers have created a black market of stolen and aggregated consumer data that they used to break into people's accounts, steal their money, or impersonate them. In October, dark web researcher Vinny Troia found one such trove sitting exposed and easily accessible on an unsecured server, comprising 4 terabytes of personal information—about 1.2 billion records in all. While the collection is impressive for its sheer volume, the data doesn't include sensitive information like passwords, credit card numbers, or Social Security numbers. It does, though, contain profiles of hundreds of millions of people that include home and cell phone numbers, associated social media profiles like Facebook, Twitter, LinkedIn, and Github, work histories seemingly scraped from LinkedIn, almost 50 million unique phone numbers, and 622 million unique email addresses.

"It's bad that someone had this whole thing wide open," Troia says. "This is the first time I've seen all these social media profiles collected and merged with user profile information into a single database on this scale. From the perspective of

an attacker, if the goal is to impersonate people or hijack their accounts, you have names, phone numbers, and associated account URLs. That's a lot of information in one place to get you started."

Troia found the server while looking for exposures with fellow security researcher Bob Diachenko on the web scanning services BinaryEdge and Shodan. The IP address for the server simply traced to Google Cloud Services, so Troia doesn't know who amassed the data stored there. He also has no way of knowing if anyone else found and downloaded the data before he did, but notes that the server was easy to find and access. WIRED checked six people's personal email addresses against the data set; four were there and returned accurate profiles. Troia reported the exposure to contacts at the Federal Bureau of Investigation. Within a few hours, he says, someone pulled the server and the exposed data offline. The FBI declined to comment for this story. Of Unknown Origin

The data Troia discovered seems to be four data sets cobbled together. Three were labeled, perhaps by the server owner, as coming from a data broker based in San Francisco called People Data Labs. PDL claims on its website to have data on over 1.5 billion people for sale, including almost 260 million in the US. It also touts more than a billion personal email addresses, more than 420 million LinkedIn URLs, more than a billion Facebook URLs and IDs, and more than 400 million phone numbers, including more than 200 million valid US cell-phone numbers.



PDL cofounder Sean Thorne says that his company doesn't own the server that hosted the exposed data, an assessment Troia agrees with based on his limited visibility. It's also unclear how the records got there in the first place. "The owner of this server likely used one of our enrichment products, along with a number of other data-enrichment or licensing services," says Sean Thorne, cofounder of People Data Labs. "Once a customer receives data from us, or any other data providers, the data is on their servers and the security is their responsibility. We perform free security audits, consultations, and workshops with the majority of our customers."

Troia thinks it's unlikely that People Data Labs was breached, since it would be simpler to just buy data from the company. An attacker on a budget could also sign up for a free trial that PDL advertises, offering 1,000 consumer profiles per month. "One thousand profiles to 1,000 burner accounts and you've got pretty much all of it," Troia points out. One of the other data sets is labeled

"OXY," and every record in it also contains an "OXY" tag. Troia speculates that this may refer to Wyoming-based data broker Oxydata, which claims to have 4 TB of data, including 380 million profiles on consumers and employees in 85 industries and 195 countries around the world. Martynas Simanuskas, Oxydata director of business-to-business sales, emphasized that Oxydata hasn't suffered a breach and that it does not label its data with an "OXY" tag.



The fact that neither data broker could rule out the possibility that one of their customers mishandled their data speaks to the larger security and privacy issues inherent in the business of buying and selling data.

"What stands out about this incident is the sheer volume of data that's been collected and how it's been aggregated, stored, and commercialized without the knowledge of the data owners. My own personal information is in there," says security researcher Troy Hunt, who runs the comprehensive data exposure tracking service HavelBeenPwned. "We're definitely seeing more data than ever circulating. It's not just due to more data breaches, it's also due to the propagation of data that's already been breached. We're seeing that data then taken by other services, duplicated, then breached again."

As with some of his past disclosures, Troia provided information from the trove to Hunt for HavelBeenPwned. In all, Hunt added more than 622 million unique email addresses and other data to his repository, and is currently notifying the HavelBeenPwned network.

Neverending Leaks

This data exposure is just the latest in a seemingly endless string of large-scale

discoveries. At the beginning of this year, 2.2 billion records were found distributed on hacker forums across several tranches known as Collections #1-5. In March, Troia and Diachenko discovered that a single email marketing firm called Verifications.io had left 809 million records publicly accessible. In 2018 the marketing firm Exactis leaked a database of 340 million personal records, and a breach of the sales intelligence firm Apollo exposed billions of data points.

For the first quarter of 2019, the number of both data breaches and data exposures was up significantly compared to 2018. Troia, who runs the threat intelligence firm Data Viper, says that over the past few years he has been building out a repository of exposed data to use in scanning and tracking. At the end of 2017 he says he was struggling to get 4 billion records into the platform. By March 2018, he had ingested 5 billion. Today he has compiled more than 13 billion. "That's a huge, massive jump," Troia says.

Just because data is exposed online doesn't mean hackers have accessed it, and often the data involved is simply culled from public records. But in aggregate, these troves can create real risk by enabling identity theft, credential stuffing, and phishing scams. Much of the data also winds up on the dark web, which has seen a recent explosion of stolen credentials, according to recent research from the Swiss IT security testing and dark-web monitoring firm ImmuniWeb.

"Some of the public information that might be gathered into one spot is already out there—if you look at the white pages you had somebody's phone number and you had somebody's address—it's just that it's a lot easier to get access now and exploit it at a mass scale," he says. "Given the proliferation, just how much data is out there, somebody is going to find a way to exploit even the most mundane items of information." (Courtesy wired.com)
